Step 1


Press "END" key to turn on the phone. Please wait till "Looking for service..." shows up on the display.

With "Looking for service..." on the display, please press "OK" key, select the "Tools" icon and press "OK" key.



# Step 3

When the "Tools" menu shows up, please select "4 Bluetooth" and press "OK".

When the "Bluetooth Settings" menu shows up, please select "6.BT FCC TRx" at the bottom and press "OK" key.

## 3. Bluetooth testing function detail

#### 3.1. Bluetooth Channel

Here is the menu to set the Bluetooth transmit channel.

Please select the channel with "Menu" key (upward and downward), and press "OK" key.

When you want to go back to the previous menu, please press "Back" key.

\* You can only select Low, Middle or High channel.

#### 3.2. Bluetooth Power

This menu is for setting Bluetooth transmit output power with On/On(EDR DQPSK)/On(EDR D8PSK)/Off/DUT modes.

Please select the channel with "Menu" key (upward and downward), and press "OK" key. When you want to go back to the previous menu, please press "Back" key.

On/On(EDR DQPSK)/On(EDR D8PSK) corresponds to the following modulation method respectively:

On : GFSK(Basic Rate)
On (EDR DQPSK) : DQPSK(EDR)
On (EDR D8PSK) : D8PSK(EDR)

The device transmits at the maximum power when you select the mode On/On(EDR DQPSK)/On(EDR D8PSK) from the menu.

**DUT function is not available.** Please do not select this menu.

#### 3.3. Hopping

Here is the menu for turning ON/OFF the Bluetooth hopping frequency.

Please select the channel with "Menu" key (upward and downward), and press OK".

When you want to go back to the previous menu, please press "Back" key.

#### 3.4. Direct Channel Change

Here is the menu for changing channel (0-78) with the numeric and delete keys.

Please select the packet type with "Menu" key (upward and downward), and press "OK" key.

When you want to go back to the previous menu, please press "Back" key.

\*You can only select DH1, DH3 or DH5 packet type.

#### 4. How to use Bluetooth headset

When you use Bluetooth headset, please make sure to follow these steps:

- 1. Powercycle the phone (power off the phone then back on)
- 2. Turn Bluetooth on
- 3. Connect the phone to a headset.

When you use the functions in Section 4, please follow the steps below BEFORE performing Operation Procedure in section 3.

- 1. Turn Bluetooth off under Tools menu
- 2. Powercycle the phone (power off the phone then back on)
