GETTING STARTED

Remove the R/C vehicle and controller from the package. Insert batteries into the R/C vehicle and controller to begin full function play. See "Battery Installation" section for further details.


CAUTION

Important Battery Information

- Dispose of batteries properly.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Use only batteries of the type recommended.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Remove batteries from R/C vehicle and controller if vehicle will not be used for a long period of time.


BATTERY INSTALLATION

CONTROLLER



1. To remove battery cover, loosen screws in open.
2. Insert 3 "AA" batteries into the controller. Be sure the + and - are properly inserted.

R/C VEHICLE



1. To remove battery cover, loosen screws in open.
2. Insert 3 "AA" batteries into the vehicle. Be sure the + and - are properly inserted.

NOTE: For best performance, always use alkaline batteries only.

STRONG BATTERY MEANS OPTIMUM PERFORMANCE
Keep the battery by turning off vehicle when not in use.

MUTE SWITCH

This unit is equipped with a mute switch. Use the mute switch when "Quiet Play" is desired. This function will allow the controller or the vehicle.

OPERATING R/C VEHICLE

DEMO OFF PLAY (Large ON/OFF PLAY or Demo button on controller) turns on the R/C vehicle to the RUN position.

DEMO ON PLAY (Small ON/OFF PLAY or Demo button on controller) turns on the R/C vehicle to the DEMO position.

OPERATING R/C VEHICLE

- Press button 1 on the controller for lights and sounds.
- Hold button 2 on the controller to drive forward.
- Hold button 3 on the controller to drive reverse.
- Press button 4 on the vehicle to drive forward with lights and sounds.
- Press button 5 on the vehicle for lights and sounds.
- Press button 6 on the vehicle for lights and sounds.

After play, always turn vehicle off. Loosen batteries from controller and R/C vehicle when not in use or when charging. Leakage may occur and cause damage if left for a long period of time.

TROUBLESHOOTING AND CARE FOR R/C VEHICLE



LIMITED RADIO CONTROL RANGE
While R/C vehicle may be visible at a distance, full operational control may be lost. Limit controller to 100 ft. in air and direct vehicle track.





INTERFERENCE
Other radio signals may cause loss of control. Remove vehicle from an area of interference.
