Care of the PhotoFrame

Do not drop

Photo Frame is a complicated electronic device and cannot withstand shock from being dropped.

2 Do not expose to moisture

Do not hit or scratch

The LCD panel of Photo Frame is made of glass and is therefore sensitive to abnormal force and sharp edges.

Screen cleaning

Keep the stand clear from cables

Make sure the stand of your Photo Frame is clear from cables as cables could pull the stand out of Photo Frame to the floor.

How to Upgrade the Firmware


- Download the Firmware. We have two files.

- Using USB Cable, connect the Photo Frame to the USB Port on your PC.
- The Photo Frame will be automatically connected in seconds and you may see "POPUP Window". Also you check the "Connected Mode" of the Screen of the Photo Frame.



- Now, Save the files as below,
 - 1) "HDDFile.TCC" Save to "CONFIG" Folder" of Photo Frame.
 - 2) "Player.rom" Save to "Root Directory" of Photo Frame.


