Inquiry:

We are seeking exemption from the requirement defined in 47 CFR 2.925(f) that specifies that if a device is so small that it is impractical to label it with the FCC identifier in a font that is four-point or larger...then the FCC identifier shall be placed in the user manual and must also either be placed on the device packaging or on a removable label attached to the device."

We are seeking exemption from the requirement that the FCC-ID must also be placed on the device packaging or on a removable label attached to the device.

We will place the FCC-ID in the user manual.
