- high, please reduce the volume. Stop using the headset if you feel obvious discomfort, irritation or
- have other adverse reactions.

  The headset should not be stored or use at temperatures below -15 C (5 F) or above 55 C (131 F) which may shorten headset or battery life.

Charging and battery
Only use charging cable supplied by Bluedio, or may cause damage to the headset. Warning


The DC voltage should be 5V and current should exceed 100mA Charging The headset built-in battery is rechargeable and non-detachable. Do

not replace the battery.

1. Connect the smaller plug of the charging cable to the USB socket

of the headset; connect the other plug to the USB socket of your computer or other changing device. There is a limit icon shown on the OLED and the headset is being charged.2. When the headset is fully charged(about 1.5-2hrs), the LED remains blue and a limit icon shown on the OLED.

Headest Overview



Press the MF button until "Bluedio" is shown on the OLED and the LED flashes blue.

## Pairing mode

Keep the MF button pressed until the LED remains blue. Reconnection mode Keep the MF button pressed until the LED flashes blue.

Power off

### Keep the MF button pressed until the LED flashed blue then goes out. Pair the headset with your mobile phone

Keep the distance between the headset and your mobile phone (or other Bluetooth device) within 1 meter. The closer, the better.

2. Power on the headset, and make sure it enters into pairing mode

3. Switch on the Bluetooth function(Android: Scan for device) of your mobile phone, on which start a search for Bluetooth devices.

4. From the found Bluetooth devices, select "16" to establish a Bluetooth

connection to the headset. If necessary, enter the default PIN code "0000". 5. The headset is paired with your mobile phone.

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Attention: If pairing is not successful within 60 seconds, the LED flashes blue and the headset is out of pairing mode. Repeat the pairing procedure. Pair with two mobile phones:

1.Keep the distance between the headset and mobile phone1 within 1

2.Power on the headset and ensure it enters into pairing mode

Switch on the Bluetooth function(Android: Scan for device)of phone 1, search "i6", pair and connect the headset.
 Switch off Bluetooth of phone 1, and power off the headset.

5.Power on the headset again and ensure it enters into pairing mode: Switch on Bluetooth of mobile phone 2, search "16", pair and connect the headset.

6. Switch on Bluetooth of phone 1, and connect the paired headset.

Disconnect the headset with your mobile phone 1. Switch the headset off.

Or switch off the Bluetooth function of your mobile phone.
 Or take the headset from your mobile phone 20m (60tt) away or even

farther. Reconnect the paired headset to your mobile phone

1.Keep the distance between the headset and your mobile phone(or other

Bluetooth device) within 1 meter. The closer, the better,

2.Power on the headset, and make sure it enters into reconnection mode 3.9witch on the Bluetooth function of your mobile phone. The headset will automatically reconnect to it.

When there comes a call, the LED flashes blue and a # icon shown on the OLED. Press the MF button once, or use your mobile phone to answer it End a call Press the MF button once. Or use your mobile phone to end it.

Reject a call

After hearing a beep, keep the MF button pressed for around 2 seconds or use your mobile phone to reject it.

Call waiting (need your mobile phone to support)
When you are on call 1, there comes call 2; to answer call 2 and keep call 1: keep the MF button pressed for around 2 seconds.

When call 2 ends, to switch back to call 1: keep the MF button pressed for Redial the last call

Press the MF button twice

Voice prompt selection

Switch the headset on, press the MF button and Vol- button once at the same time to select English/Chinese/French/Spanish.

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Voice control/need your mobile phone to support

Keep the MF button pressed for around 2 seconds Muting

When you are on call, keep the Vol- button pressed to mute the Microphone; keep the Vol+ button pressed to cancel the muting.

Being a Bluetooth receiver

Connect the headset with your mobile phone via Bluetooth, then connect the headset to amplifier via audio cable.

EQ adjustment(only in Bluetooth mode)

When the headset is playing music, press the Vol+ button and Vol- button once at the same time.

Track control / Volume adjustment

Play/Pause track: press the MF button once

Select track : keep pressing the Vol(+) button/ Vol(-) button Volume up: press the Vol(\*) button once(to the maximum, there is a beep) Volume down: press the Vol(-) button once(to the minimum, there is a beep)

FAQ 1.Headphone cannot pair with mobile phone

Solution: Please check whether your headphone is in pairing mode or reconnection mode, check whether Bluetooth search function of your mobile phone has been opened. Thus, check your mobile device's Bluetooth me and delete/forget the headphone, reconnect the headphone following

nstructions of user manual.

2.Headphone cannot be switch on. Solution: Please check the battery status of your headphone.

3.Can I change battery for the headphone?

Solution: No, this headphone use a built-in non-detachable Li-Polymer battery, it cannot be removed.

4.Can I use headphone while driving?

Solution: For safety reason, we strongly recommend not to use over-ear headphone to avoid distraction while driving.

5.Headphone disconnect with your mobile phone within 10 meter. Solution: Please check if there is metal or other material within relatively close range may interfere Bluetooth connection, as Bluetooth is a radio technology that is sensitive to objects between the headphone and the connected device.

6.Cannot hearing a sound from your computer or mobile phone. Solution: Please check whether the output channel of your computer is Bluetooth Audio Device and Bluetooth function of your computer support A2DP profile. And please check volume of your headphone, and computer/mobile phone.

Cannot hearing a sound from source and audio streaming application.

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Solution: Check the source of streaming audio is on and playing. Or check that the device supports A2DP audio streaming. Or try other source / audio streaming app or try another track. Or check the Bluetooth device volume is at a high level and not muted. Or place the device to headphones (10 meters). Or take device and headphones away for any device that may cause interference. like other Bluetooth devices, cordless phones, microwave ovens or wireless computer network routers. Or reduce the number of applications running on the device. The audio quality will also be improved by turning off the Wi-Fi functionality of the device.

8.Cannot use the headphone to control volume or select track of APP of your mobile phone.

Solution: Software settings of APP may be varied led to some functions of

the APP may not control by the headphone.

9.Cannot charge the headphone.

Solution: Make sure both ends of the USB cable are securely connected. If you use a power outlet, ensure that the power supply is connected securely and the outlet works. If you use a computer, make sure it is connected and the USB port is powered. Turn on the headset and then turn them off. Disconnect and reconnect the USB charging cable.
