







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<h3>4.2.Pairing Q9 to Mobile phone</h3> <p>To use your Bluetooth Headset Q9, you must first pair your Bluetooth Headset to the mobile phone. Pairing is a one time process. Once your Headset is paired to a specific mobile phone, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range. If the connection between the phone and Headset is lost, tap the "action" button on the Q9 to reconnect the device.</p> <h4>Pairing the Headset to a Bluetooth mobile phone:</h4> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Turn on your phone and ensure its Bluetooth function is activated. ■ Turn on the Headset Q9 and continue to press the "action" button about 6 seconds until your headset to enter to pairing mode, then the LED LED flash rapidly. ■ Search your Bluetooth devices on your phone by following the phone's instructions. Refer to your phone's user manual for more information. ■ After a few second the phone will list the Headset Q9 as a discover device. Select it and follow your phone instruction to select this pairing. ■ Then your phone will request a passkey or PIN, enter 0000 as your PIN or passkey. ■ Your phone will confirm the pairing, and then press Yes/Ok. After it, the LED of your Q9 will turn off the flash. ■ Finally, select to connect with your Q9 from your phone. 	<h3>4.3.Charging your Q9</h3> <p>The Headset Q9 is convenient to connect to AC charger or a USB charger with Mini DC 2.0 port. Make sure that your Bluetooth Headset Q9 is fully charged for at least 4 hours before initial use. Insert one terminal of your charger to AC main or USB port of PC and other terminal to DC 2.0 jack on side of Q9. While charging, the LED of Q9 light constantly. The LED is lighted when it starts charging. 2) There is no sound when answer a call. 	<p>Ans: Check to see if the volume is adjusted too low. If it is too low, turn it up. Make sure the Headset is paired and connected with your target phone.</p> <p>3) How can I know the Headset has been fully charged?
