

#### Hands Free

#### Charging: This headset uses a non detachable built-in Li-Polymer rechargeable battery.

- 1. Before charging, make sure the headset is
- 2. Plug USB cable into the charging port of headset; plug other side of USB charging cable into the USB charger or other charging device. Charging will start
- 3. When the headset has been fully charged, blue light remains bright or red light switch off after charging completed.

Keep press the "MF button" around 5 seconds to sound. The blue light blinks.

Keep press the "MF button" around 3 seconds to switch off the headset. The headset will issue a beep sound. The blue light blinks two times, then switch off.

# ■ To pairing your headset with your mobile phone

- 1. Keep distance of the headset and mobile phone within 1m when pairing, the closer the better.
- 2. Switch on the headset, after the blue light blinks the blue light will remains bright, at the same time the headset enters to pairing mode
