Security Precautions: In order to have a proper and safety use of the headset, please read this user manual in detail and save it.

△ Be sure to aware the following guidelines when using your headset.

- To avoid long time exposure to high volume, leading to noise-induced hearing damage.
- Should use caution or temporarily discontinue use in potentially hazardous situations.
- Should adjust reasonable volume and time when listening to music.
- Be careful not to turn the volume too high, as you do not hear anything around you.
- Do not recommend using a headset while driving.
- Driving on the way or in a potential dangerous environment, please avoid using headset to listen to the music, make or receive calls, in order to avoid dispersion attention.
- Should avoid continuing to increase the headset volume, as your hearing need adaptation.
- Keep this product and its accessories out of the reach of children, in order to avoid inappropriate use by children which may pose a fatal danger
- Should avoid immerse in water during grooming, which may cause damage to the sound quality or the headset.
- Stop using headset if feel significant discomfort, irritation or other adverse reactions.

■ Charger and battery:

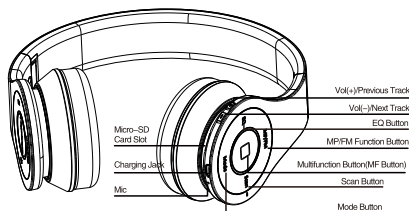
△ Warning:

1. Please check the charging cable is original or not before charging the Bluetooth headset.
2. Must use original charge cable to charge for the Bluetooth headset, otherwise it may damage the Bluetooth headset. Thus, voltage of charger must be 5V, electric current exceed 200mA.
3. This headset uses a non detachable built-in rechargeable battery.

Charging:

1. Before charging, make sure the headset has switched off.
2. Plug USB cable into the charging port of headset; plug other side of USB cable into the USB charger or other charging device. Charging will start and the red light remains bright on the headset.
3. The headset takes approximately up to 4 hours for fully charged, blue light remains bright or red light switch off after charging completed.

■ Switch On/Off

- Keep press the “MF Button” for around 7 seconds until blue light remains bright. Press the “MF Button” for around 4 seconds entered to reconnection mode, green light blinks.
- Keep press the “MF Button” for around 4 seconds until you hear the beep sound, after the blue light blinks, headset will be switch off.

■ To pairing your headset with your mobile phone:

1. Keep distance of the headset and mobile phone(or other device need to be connected) within 1 meter when pairing.
2. Keep press the “MF Button” for around 7 seconds to switch on the headset, blue light remains bright, entered to pairing mode.
3. Switch on Bluetooth search function in your mobile phone or other device need to be connected, the mobile phone will display has found the “B”.
4. Select “B”, your headset will be automatically connected to your mobile phone, the blue light blinks.

- “If Bluetooth function of your headset has switched off, keep press the “MF Button” for around 4 seconds, until blue light blinking into pairing mode, the headset and mobile phone will be reconnected automatically.

Hands Free Functions

IMPORTANT: The pairing time is limited, generally takes 60 seconds. If blue light disappeared, the Bluetooth pairing mode has stopped. If pairing is unsuccessful, please retry step 1 to 4 again.

Disconnect the headset from the mobile phone:

Using any one of the following ways:

Switch off Bluetooth search function of your mobile phone, Or;
Keep press the “MF Button” for around 4 seconds, blue light blinks and issue the beep sound, the headset will automatically shut down, Or;
Move the headset away from the mobile phone for 20m (66ft) or farther position.

Reconnect the paired headset with the mobile phone:

- When the headset is switched off, keep press the “MF Button” for around 4 seconds, the blue light blinks and issue the beep sound to switch on the headset, and switch on your mobile phone's Bluetooth search function, the phone will found “B”.
- Select “B”, your mobile phone will automatically connect with your headset, the blue light will blink after reconnection. (Some mobile phone's Bluetooth menu support to set turn on headset automatically to establish a connection with the mobile phone)

Answer incoming call:

- When Bluetooth headset is connected to your mobile phone, the headset will issue a call tone or a ringtone when there is an incoming call, the blue light blinking rapidly in every 4 seconds, press the “MF Button” once to answer incoming call or use answer button of your mobile phone to answer a incoming call.

Drop call:

- Press the “MF Button” once or use your mobile phone button to hang up a call.

Reject call:

- Incoming call, keep press the “MF Button” for around 2 seconds, or directly use your mobile phone hang up button, to reject the call.

Call waiting:

- If there is another incoming call when you are calling, keep press the “MF Button” for around 2 seconds and release, it will be able to keep the first call, while answering the second incoming call. After finished the second call, keep press the “MF Button” for around 2 seconds and release, to catch the first call again. (Whether to support this function depends on the mobile phone)

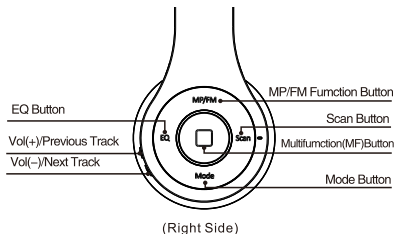
Hands Free Functions

Last call redialing:

- Double-click on the MF Button to dial out the last phone call.

Play Bluetooth music:

- After connecting the headset with your mobile phone via Bluetooth, press the “MF Button” once to play/pause music.



Play Micro-SD card music:

- Plug in Micro-SD card with music file.
- Connect your headset with mobile phone via Bluetooth function/or keep press the “MF Button” for around 4 seconds, blue light blinks to switch on the headset.
- Keep press the “MP/FM Function Button” for around 4 seconds, until green light remains bright, entered to Micro-SD card mode.
- Under Micro-SD card mode, press the “MP/FM Function Button” once can play or pause music.
- Press the “Volume Up Button” or “Volume Down Button” once can choose previous or next track. Keep press the “Volume Up Button” or “Volume Down Button” can adjust volume.
- Keep press the “MP/FM Function Button” for around 4 seconds can switch off Micro-SD card mode, back to Bluetooth music mode.

*If the headset doesn't connect to mobile phone via Bluetooth, will not support hands free call.

Remark1: Press the “Mode Button” can convert between Micro-SD card mode and FM mode/Remove Micro-SD card will change to FM mode.

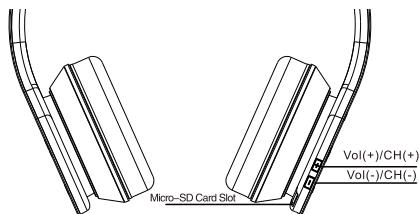
Remark2: Remove Micro-SD card under Micro-SD card mode, headset will change to FM mode. Insert Micro-SD card under FM mode, headset will change to Micro-SD card mode. But it may affect function of the headset, do not suggest the above usage.

Additional Functions

Remark3: Under Micro-SD card music mode, press “EQ Button” can change to 5 kind of music style; include POP, ROCK, COUNTRY, CLASSIC and JAZZ.

Listening to radio:

1. Take out Micro-SD card (if applicable), connect your headset with mobile phone via Bluetooth function"/or keep press the “MP/FM Function Button” for around 4 seconds, blue light blinks to switch on the headset.
2. Keep press the “MP/FM Function Button” for around 4 seconds, until green light remains bright, entered to FM mode. Press the “Scan Button” once can start to search radio channel, when search finished, will start to broadcast radio.
3. Under FM mode, press the “MP/FM Function Button” once can play or pause the radio.
4. Press the “Volume Up Button” or “Volume Down Button” once can choose previous or next channel. Keep press the “Volume Up Button” or “Volume Down Button” can adjust volume.
5. Keep press the “MP/FM Function Button” for around 4 seconds can switch off FM mode, back to Bluetooth music mode.

Micro-SD card file transfer:

- Insert Micro-SD card to the headset, use USB charging cable to connect your headset with computer to start file (incl. music) transfer.

Bluetooth music mode switch to Micro-SD card mode /FM mode:

- Under Bluetooth music play mode, in order to play Micro-SD card music, you need to switch off your Bluetooth device which has been connected, or disconnect the headset and Bluetooth device. Keep press the “MP/FM Function Button” for around 4 seconds, until green light remains bright,

entered to Micro-SD card mode and FM mode. If Micro-SD card has plugged in, the headset will play music of Micro-SD card, if no, will enter to FM mode.

- If the headset has connected with mobile phone, there is an incoming call while Micro-SD card music of FM radio is playing, it will switch to ringtone automatically, blue light blinks rapidly in every 4 seconds, when the call finished, it will switch back to Micro-SD card music or FM radio.

Select tracks and volume control:

1. Keep presses the “Volume Up Button” or “Volume Down Button” to adjust volume of Bluetooth mode, Micro-SD card mode and FM mode.
2. Press “Volume Up Button” and “Volume down Button” once to select previous track/channel or next track/channel of Bluetooth mode, Micro-SD card mode and FM mode..
3. When adjusting the volume of Bluetooth music, it will issue the beep sound under maximum or minimum volume. No beep sound in Micro-SD card mode and FM mode.
