



2 Safety Precautions

Welcome to your new Bluedio headphones
We appreciate your choice of Bluedio headphones. Before use, please read the user manual carefully and keep for future reference.

Purchase verification

Please read the user manual carefully and keep for future reference.

Important Safety Information

- DON'T use the headphones at a high volume for any extended period to prevent hearing damage.
- DON'T use the headphones while driving or in any environment requiring your full attention.
- Always keep the headphones dry and DON'T use the headphones during the winter.
- DON'T use the headphones to either actively high or in an environment (0 to 120°C).
- In the case of a chargeable battery in the headphones that is considered to be a certified performance, DON'T try to replace the battery on your own.

3 Charging/Pairing

Charging the battery
The battery needs to be charged when you hear "Please charge" or you see the red light blink.

1. Turn off the headphones before charging.
2. Plug the included or purchased charging cable into the charging connector on the headphones. Plug the larger end of the USB end charger connector into a power source.
3. When charging, the red light stays on.
4. When fully charged, the blue light stays on.

Pairing mode
When the headphones are off (if not, turn off the headphones first), press and hold the MF Button until you hear "Pairing" or you see the blue light stays on (instead of blinking).

Pairing

1. Make sure the headphones are in pairing mode. The "Pairing" light blinks.
2. Make sure the headphones have entered pairing mode. (See instruction "Entering pairing mode".)
3. Go to your phone's Bluetooth settings, add or search for a new device. (See instruction "Bluetooth settings on phone".)
4. Select "Vinyl Plus" from your device list. (If selected for a previous device, select "Forget this device".)
5. Enter the PIN Code. (The headphones and your phone will successfully paired and connected.)
6. Press the MF Button. (The headphones and your phone have entered pairing mode, the blue light blinks, and the headphones are out of pairing mode. Please turn off the headphones and try pairing again.)

Turning the headphones on/off
ON: Press and hold the MF Button until you hear "Power on" or you see the red and blue light comes on.
OFF: Press and hold the MF Button until you hear "Power off" or you see the red and blue light comes on.

4 Overview

Headphones Overview

It has

- Microphone
- Auto-answer
- USB charging cable

Connecting to 2 mobile phones

1. Make sure the headphones are in 2 mobile phones. The "2 mobile" light blinks.
2. Make sure the headphones have entered pairing mode. (See instruction "Entering pairing mode".)
3. Go to the Bluetooth settings on phone 1, turn on the Bluetooth feature, add or search devices, select "Vinyl Plus" from the device list.
4. Turn on the Bluetooth feature on phone 1, and turn off the headphones.
5. Make sure the headphones have entered pairing mode. (See instruction "Entering pairing mode".)
6. Go to the Bluetooth settings on phone 2, turn on the Bluetooth feature, add or search devices, select "Vinyl Plus" from the device list.
7. Turn on the Bluetooth feature of phone 2, and the headphones will connect to phone 2 automatically. (If an already connected device, please "Forget this device" on phone 1, turn off the headphones and try pairing again.)

Reconnecting the paired headphones to your phone

1. Make sure the headphones are in pairing mode. The "Pairing" light blinks.
2. Make sure the headphones are in the paired connection mode. When you see the blue light blinks, the headphones are in the pairing mode.
3. Turn on the Bluetooth feature of your phone, and the headphones will connect to your phone automatically. (If an already connected device, please "Forget this device" on your phone. Turn off the headphones and try pairing again.)

Disconnecting the headphones from your phone
Turn off the headphones or turn off the Bluetooth feature on your phone.

5 Talk

Note: To "Bluetooth mode" means the headphones and your phone are connected via Bluetooth.

Using the headphones to talk to Bluetooth mode

To answer a call
When you hear a ringtone, there is an incoming call. To answer the call, press the MF Button once.

To end a call
When you are on call, end it by pressing the MF Button once.

To reject a call
When you hear a ringtone, there is an incoming call. To reject the call, press and hold the MF Button for 3 seconds.

To make the last number
Press the MF Button twice, you will hear a beep and the last call log.

Notes that must be supported by your mobile phone

Call waiting (not supported by your mobile phone)

1. To answer call 1, press the MF Button once.
2. To answer call 2, press and hold the MF Button until you hear a beep.
3. When you are on call 2, press and hold the MF Button until you hear a beep.
4. To reject call 1, press and hold the MF Button for 3 seconds.
5. To reject call 2, press and hold the MF Button for 3 seconds.
6. To reject call 1 & call 2: Press the MF Button once.

Track /Volume control (in Bluetooth mode)

Play/Pause: Press the MF Button once.
Stop/Forward: Press and hold the MF Button once.
Back: Press and hold the MF Button once.
Volume Up: Press the MF Button once.
Volume Down: Press the MF Button once.

Auto-answer

1. Plug the included audio cable into the jack on the headphones. (The audio cable must be plugged on your device.)
2. Make sure the headphones are turned off before using the auto-answer.

Answering incoming phone

1. Connect the headphones to your phone via Bluetooth.
2. Connect the headphones to other audio devices or your phone via the audio cable.

Turning 3D sound on/off (in Bluetooth mode)
ON: When the headphones are playing stereo music, press the MF Button and the MF Button together then release the buttons immediately. You will hear a low and the 3D sound effect.
OFF: When the 3D sound is on, press the MF Button and the MF Button together then release the buttons immediately. You will hear a low and the 3D sound effect.

Changing the headphones memory

1. Make sure the headphones are in pairing mode. (See instruction "Entering pairing mode".)
2. Press the MF Button and the MF Button together then release the buttons immediately. All Bluetooth devices are cleared from the headphones.

7 FAQ

1. Headphones cannot be paired to your mobile phone.
Solution: Check if the headphones have entered pairing mode. Check if your mobile phone supports the HSP or HFP profile. Check if the Bluetooth search function of your phone is switched on. Check if your mobile phone is in range of the headphones and your phone exceeds 10m.

2. Headphones cannot be turned on.
Solution: The battery needs to be charged. Recharge the battery.

3. Can the battery be replaced?
Solution: No. The battery is not user-replaceable.

4. Can the headphones be used while driving?
Solution: Answer: DON'T use the headphones in an environment that requires your special attention.

5. Bluetooth connection is suddenly interrupted while in use.
Solution: Check if there is metal or other material between the headphones and the transmission device. Turn off the headphones and try pairing again.

6. No sound signal.
Solution: Check if the headphones are turned off. Turn on the headphones and try pairing. If necessary, pair the headphones with the audio source again. Check the connection to your audio source.

7. Can the headphones be used to control the APPs on your mobile phone?
Solution: Some functions of APPs may be varied. Thus some APPs may not be controlled by the headphones.

8. The headphones can't be recharged.
Solution: Solution: Check the connection of USB. If necessary, remove the USB cable and plug again. Turn on the headphones then turn it off.
