- i) The device is handheld.
- ii) The FCC Identifier (ID) is visible at the time of purchase. Marketing the device without the battery installed when the label is in the battery compartment is acceptable. The FCC ID on the box or additional documentation directing the user where to find the FCC label also satisfies this requirement.
- iii) The user accessible area must not require any special tools for access and the FCC label must not be placed on a removable part.
- iv) The FCC ID, Model Number, or FCC logo must be on the label and must meet all general labeling requirements or policies that apply for Certification, Verification of Declaration of Conformity (DoC); e.g. for Certification, for handheld Part 15 or 18 devices.

Furthermore, the Bluetooth and WiFi transmitters can be operational at the same time. User can configure the radio on the control panels inside Windows CE environment by click the ON icon.
