I am processing a Change of Identification application. The original device was certified for both radio and digital device, FCC ID: QIPHC25. The Change of Id application submittal only addressed the radio certification. Is this permissible, or does the Change of Id application have to include all elements of the original certification?

I assume that the Change of Id will have to include both the JBP and the radio certifications. Please confirm.

Response:

You can obtain a new FCC Id for just the radio device if you plan to market the device in this manner or you can get a new FCC Id for a device with both a wireless radio and a digital device if this is how you intend to market the device. You may also Certify the wireless radio and approve the digital device by Verification or if a Class B computer peripheral by Declaration of Conformity.
