To Whom It May Concern:

We, VSOMD-100D , would like to submit the following justification to show the frequency range (136-174MHz) on the Grant of Equipment Authorization under (Part 90) for FCCID: VSOMD-100D  
Per the FCC's KDB634817 guidance, as an alternative to listing the exact frequencies, we acknowledge that it's a violation of the FCC Rules if this device operations on unauthorized frequencies. This radio is intended for use by federal agencies, public agencies, emergency services, as well as commercial, business, and industrial services. Additionally, it will be used in other countries that accept the FCC Grant of Equipment Authorization. These services account for a majority of users as described in the below table

This radio complies with 47 CFR Part 90.203(e) in that the operator cannot program and transmit on frequencies, other than those programmed by the manufacturer, service or maintenance personnel, using the equipment's external operation controls. It is noted that the FCC rules would be violated if this radio is programmed to operate on frequencies outside of FCC (Part 90) Frequency Bands for users other than the (Federal Government).
