


This package include 6 parts:




## **Installation**

- 1. Installation Handsfree Box
- 1.1. Choose a suitable mounting location for the handsfree box.
- 1.2. Screw the Handsfree Box screwing holes
- 1.3. Connect ISO connector for radio speaker or 4 pin power leads if external speaker is used.
- 2. Installation Phone cradle.
- 2.1. Fix the cradle by screws provided.
- 3. Installation to Mic
- 3.1. Put the mic on the car sunvisor.

When installation, pls also refer to connecting diagram A and Diagram B as well.



# Pairing procedure


- Step 1: Power on Cartel.
- Step 2: Activate the phone "SEARCH" for bluetooth device.

  Pls refer phone user manual how to activate.
- Step 3: In "SEARCH", phone displays a list of bluetooth device(s), pls select CT-1000
- Step 4: Enter generic pass code "1234" to associate "Pair" and connect the CT-1000
- Step 5: Once you have entered the pass code, your phone is paired for this bluetooth speakerphone.
- Step 6: This handset LCD display show your name of phone Pairing success. You could use CT-1000 now.
