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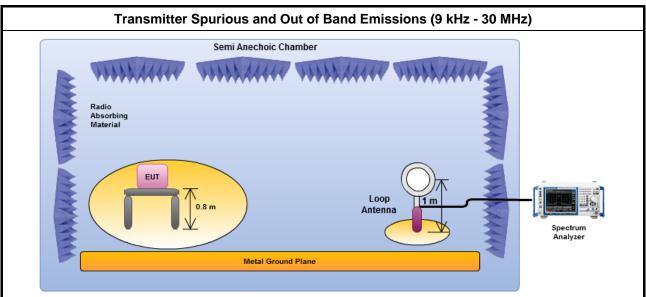

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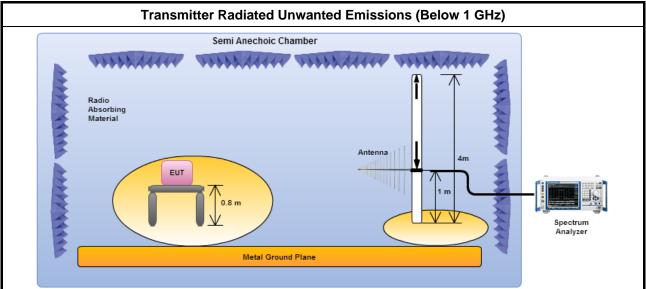


1.1.4 Test Setup



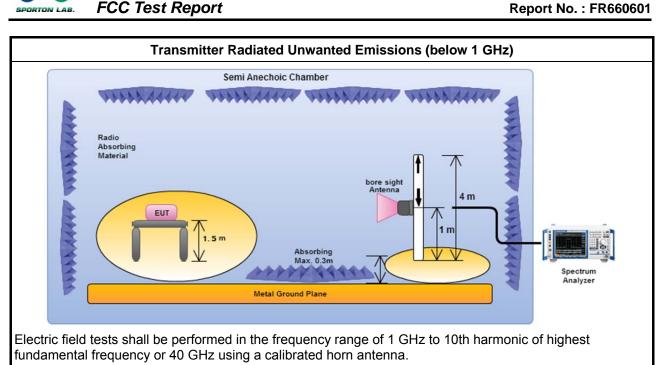
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Magnetic field tests shall be performed in the frequency range of 9 kHz to 30 MHz using a calibrated loop antenna.

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1.1.5 Transmitter Radiated Unwanted Emissions (Below 30 MHz)

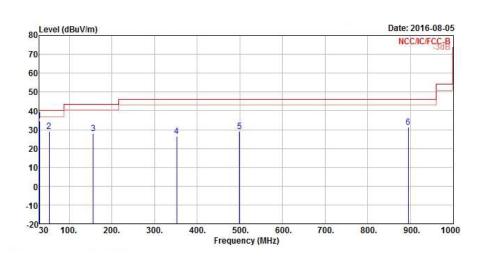
