


Fig. 20 Rear Seat Remote: Overview




Fig. 22 Display: Example of home screen (left) and sub-menu (right)




Fig. 24 Overview of Audi tablet




Fig. 25 Back of driver's/front passenger's seat: Removing Audi tablet
