I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note in the above application you state that it is a PC2. Please note that the FCC ID number listed on the 731 is VVU3122. The FCC ID number in the report is VVU73122. Please verify the FCC ID number and correct all documentation as necessary.
2. Please note that the confidentiality request lists the theory of operation as a document to be held confidential. Please provide this document or please remove it from the requested confidential documents.
3. Please note that the documentation only says the changes have been made to the layout and new model numbers have been added. Please be more specific in the description of the changes made. What changes to the layout were made? How extensive were the changes? What portions of the device was affected? Were any changes to the rf circuitry made? Etc.
4. Please provide external photos of the new models to show any differences. If there are not differences in appearance, please explain in the answer to item 3.
5. Please note that in the data table on page 23 you state 15.209 but the limits used do not appear to be from 15.209. Please use the proper limits when comparing results for compliance.
6. FYI – no action needed. Please note that the conducted power measured in this PC2 is 0.486dB lower than the original device. Please note that while still less than 0.5dB, this is getting close to the max allowed change in power.
