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

2 INSTALLING THE STAND




Follow the illustrations below to complete the installation steps.

- Secure the stand column to the base with 4 screws (ST4 x 16).
- Align column of the stand column with the groove of the base, then insert the stand column into the base. Align the stand column with the edge of the base.
- To install the stand stand, align the base stand until the screw holes are aligned.

NOTE: Product image is only for reference, actual product may vary in appearance.


4 BUTTONS AND CONNECTORS



- Secure the stand to the TV with 4 screws (ST4 x 16).
- Turn on the TV and put the TV in standby mode.
- Urging the power cord to disconnect power.
- Connect an antenna or cable to TV's back.
- Connect to a PC or other devices with a 3.5mm TRS jack.
- Connect headphones or analog sound system using a 3.5mm TRS jack.
- Connect an audio amplifier to this jack.
- Port for Digital Media Player and for software update.

3 INSTALLING A WALL-MOUNT BRACKET

- If you want to attach the TV to a wall-mount bracket (not provided), you should first remove the stand if it's pre-attached.




- When there is something wrong with your TV, you can try turning off the TV and restarting it. You can also refer to the following chart for problem and solution tips.

- SYMPTOMS**
- No sound or picture**: Confirm power cord is plugged into the AC outlet and the AC outlet is getting electricity. Turn on power to the TV set. Turn on all appliances. If interference goes away, move appliance further away from the TV set or another power outlet.
 - Check if the cable connection on the external source and for the correct input connection on the TV.**
 - Make sure you have made the correct selection on the input mode in the incoming signal.**




7 SPECIFICATIONS

- POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS**
- It flicks and while picture isn't a picture, it flicks and white.**: Check if the cable connection on the external source and for the correct input connection on the TV.
 - Sound and picture distorted or appear wavy.**: Make sure you have made the correct selection on the input mode in the incoming signal.
 - Sound and picture is blurry or CRTC don't work when I switch to Cable.**: After switching to Cable, please auto program the channels. Then TV will "remember" all the channels then they will allow you to sort the channels with (CH/V) buttons.
 - They work with the All setting.**: Confirm that TV still has power and is operational.
 - Change the batteries in the remote control.**
 - Clean the front of the remote control LED window.**
 - If the remote still does not work.**: Remove and reinsert the batteries correctly to reset the remote or install new batteries.
 - Check if there is obstruction between the remote control and the TV.**
 - If you have a digital camera or camcorder, you can aim the front of the remote at camera lenses. (at this time, the camera should be set on camera mode, not on play mode) Observe the camera screen while pressing a button on the remote control, you should see a test pattern on the screen. If there is no light observed, the remote control is not working. You need to repair or replace the remote control.**

► DIGITAL OUTPUT

- Connect an optical cable from audio out of the TV.

► HEADPHONE

- Connect headphones for audio out of the TV.

► CHANGE THE BATTERIES

- Side the back cover to open the battery compartment of the remote control.
- Insert two AAA size batteries. Make sure to match the (+) and (-) ends of the batteries with the (+) and (-) ends of the battery compartment.
- Close the battery compartment cover.

► Set the sleep timer

► Change the position and type before making any connections. Loose connections can result in image or color problems. Make sure that all connections are tight and secure.

► Connect an outdoor VHF/UHF antenna.

► Select the channel.

► Caution: Turn off the TV to receive power even in standby mode.

► URGING the power cord to disconnect power.

► Connect an antenna or cable to TV's back.
