



Paring

Press and hold the power on/off button for 2 seconds to turn device on or odd.

Volume up +:

Short press the volume up +button to turn up volume. Press and hold the + button (2S) to go to the next track.

Volume dowm -:

Short press the volume up -button to turn up volume. Press and hold the - button (2S) to go to the previous track.

Speaker pairing:

To pair the speaker:

1.Turn on the spaker ,find the Cannonball MAX speaker in your device's Bluetooth list,and select.

Disconnecting device:

2.Press the Pause/Play button for up to 3 seconds to disconnect the speaker from the device and enter into pairing mode.

Pair 2 for party mode:

1.Turn on both speaker.Press and hold the + and -buttons on each speaker until the lights blink and you will hear the voice prompt indicating the speakers have entered into search mode.

2.It will take up to 15 seconds for the speaker to find each other.Once paried, it will be followed by left channel and right channel voice prompts.

3.To unpair 2 speaker, press and hold the + and - buttons (up to 3 seconds.)

Power on-When the speaker is turn on, a solid blue light will appear momentarily.

Bluetooth pairing indicator-Whn the speaker is turned on,a fiashing blue indicates

the speaker is ready to pair.Once paired ,the light will off. Power off-When the speaker is turned off,the indicator light will turn off.

Battery charging-While speaker is charging, the indicator light will turn solid red.

Once the speaker is fully charged, the light will turn off.
