BATTERY CAUTION:

1. Alkaline battery is recommended.

12. If storing product for long periods of time, make sure to remove batteries.
13. Check the product periodically for signs of damage to electrical parts; do not play with product until damage has been properly assessed.

If the unit malfunctions, please remove the batteries for one minute and reinstall again.
If the malfunctions persist, please replace with new batteries.

1.5V X 2 (not included).




Battery Requirement For the Car:






Battery Installation- Car

1. Make sure the power switch is on OFF position (Pic.1) and unlock the lock (Pic.2).
2. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw on the battery case anti-clockwise (Pic.3).
3. Open the battery door (Pic.4).
4. Put 4x AA batteries in the battery compartment as per the polarities shown inside (Pic.5).
5. Close the battery door and tighten the screw clockwise.



Battery Installation- Transmitter

1. Make sure the power switch is on OFF position.

4. Close the battery door and tighten the screw clockwise.




