## Password Input

There are several passwords that are used by your phone and its SIM card. These passwords help you protect your phone against unauthorized use.

## Phone Code

The phone password is used for restoring the factory settings. It can be also used to avoid unauthorized use of your phone. The password is preset to 1234.

## PIN Code

PIN (Personal Identification Number) code protects your SIM card against unauthorized use. The PIN code is usually supplied with the SIM card. When the PIN code request is enable, the code is asked each time the phone is switched on.
If you enter incorrect PIN code 3 times, the SIM card will be locked and you will be prompted to enter the PUK code.

## PUK Code

The PUK (Personal Unblocking Key) code is used for changing a blocked PIN code. To obtain this code please contact your service provider.

## - Important Safety Information

1. In different countries, different regulations may apply to the use of mobile phone (e.g. When driving, in hospitals, at petrol stations, in aircrafts). Note the law for using a mobile phone in your country, and turn the device off when usage is not permitted, or when dangerous situations or interference could occur.
2. Enter the message text (up to 160 characters) using the alphanumeric keys. Press the \# key to switch among upper, lower case and digit mode while press Delete soft key to edit it. Then press Save soft key to confirm, the LCD display shows Done!.

## Use SOS Function

In emergency cases, the user can press SOS button for help. If the user has preset a SOS message and selected the relative SMS receiver, after pressing the SOS button, the phone will send the SOS message before entering this SOS list calling. Up to 6 numbers can be preset as SOS list. After entering the SOS mode, the phone will dial numbers on this SOS list automatically one by one. If a busy tone is detected or a call is aborted by user, the next number will be dialed directly. It will dial up to 2 circles. After that the calling ends but the phone still sounds warning tone and the light still flashes. In this mode:

1. when the phone rings with an incoming call, it will be taken automatically. After the call the warning tone and the flash continues.
2. When a short message is received or the alarm sounds, the relevant ringer will be delayed automatically.

If you want to quit the SOS mode, press and hold the SOS button followed by OK soft key.

## Predefine SOS Message

Using this function, you can predefine an SOS message and set a receiver for it.

## SOS Message Receiver

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select $\mathbf{S O S}$ Setting, press OK soft key.
3. Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Predefine SOS Message, press OK soft key.
4. Press OK soft key to select Set SOS Message Receiver.
5. Press OK soft key again to choose a number from Phonebook. Repeatedly press the $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to move to the desired entry, press OK, the LCD display shows Done!

## SOS Message Context

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select SOS Setting, press OK soft key.
3. Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Predefine SOS Message, press OK soft key.
4. Press V key to select Set SOS Message Context, press OK soft key.

## Prior To Use

2. Use only batteries, adapter cable and charger approved by the manufacturer, otherwise this can cause the danger of explosion

## SOS Setting

## Set SOS Numbers

Using this function, you can set up to 6 SOS numbers.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select SOS Setting, press OK soft key.
3. Press OK soft key to select Set SOS Number.
4. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose from SOS No. 1 to SOS No.6, press OK.
5. Press OK soft key again to choose a number from Phonebook. Repeatedly press the $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to move to the desired entry, press OK, the LCD display shows Done!.

## SOS Call Duration

Using this function, you can set the duration of each SOS number dialling.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select SOS Setting, press OK soft key.
3. Press $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select SOS Call Duration, press OK soft key.
4. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose among $\mathbf{1}$ Minute, $\mathbf{2}$ Minutes, $\mathbf{3}$ Minutes and $\mathbf{5}$ Minutes, you can also choose Off to dial all the SOS numbers continuously. Press OK, the LCD display shows Done!.

## Profiles

There are 3 kinds of profiles: Standard, Elder and Sleep. You can select desired profile and make relative detail setting

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Profiles, press OK soft key.
3. The $\boldsymbol{V}$ icon appears on the left of the current option. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose among Standard, Elder and Sleep, then press OK soft key.
4. Select Activate, Personalization or Reset. If you select Personalization, you can set the Ringtone, SMS Alert Tone, Alert Type, Ring Volume, Keypad Volume, Vibrator and Alarm Tone according to your necessary and preferences.

## Deactivating the Alarm Feature

1. Perform the steps 1 to 3 of the previous paragraph.
2. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Off to deactivate the alarm, then press OK soft key.

## Notes: <br> - At step 5 if you have selected 12 Hours in Time Format menu, you need to enter the time in a 12-hour format and select AM or PM, otherwise you should enter the time in a 24-hour format. <br> - In standby mode, the [T] icon will appear on the LCD if you have activated the feature

## Setting Alarm

This function allows you to set a one shot alarm or a weekly alarm.

## Activating the Alarm Feature

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\Lambda}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Set Alarm, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
4. The $\boldsymbol{\checkmark}$ icon appears on the left of the current option. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select $\mathbf{O n}$ to activate the alarm, then press OK soft key.
5. You are now on the time field. Use the numeric keypad to set the time in the HH:MM (i.e. 12:05) format and use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to move the cursor, press OK soft key
6. Then press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select One shot Alarm or Weekly Alarm according to your need, press OK to confirm
7. When you hear the alarm sound, press Cancel soft key to turn it off or press Snooze soft key to let it ring again after 5 minutes.

## Signal Icon

## Auto Redial

If you activate the Auto redial function, when the line does not get through, the phone will auto redial this number after 3 seconds if you have not cancelled the call.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Call Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Auto Redial, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose $\mathbf{O n}$ to activate the feature or choose $\mathbf{O f f}$ to deactivate it
6. Press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key to confirm and exit.

## Calling Line Identification Restriction

Using this function, you can set the restriction for calling line identification.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Call Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Press $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Calling Line Identification Restriction, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose among Default Setting, On and Off.
6. Press OK soft key to confirm and exit.

## Inserting SIM Card and Battery

The Rechargeable Li-Polymer battery pack comes with your mobile phone. Insert the battery and valid SIM card before using the phone.

1. Turn off the power of the phone.
2. Slide the battery cover in the direction of the arrow and pull it out. Remove battery as shown in the figure.
3. Keep the golden connectors of SIM card facing to the phone and push in the SIM card into the slot with care.
4. Insert new battery into the battery compartment as indicated.
5. To replace the battery cover, slide the

## Notes:

- Forbid to insert or take out the card when there is power supply connected.
- The battery needs to be replaced if it does not recover its full storage capacity after recharging.


## - Charging the Mobile Phone

! Important Note: Before initial operation, YOU SHOULD FULLY CHARGE THE battery for about 4~5 hours.

To charge, plug the connector on the adapter cable in the mini USB port on the charger, then place the phone on the charger. Result: During the charging, the battery icon starts filling.


## Call Settings

## Speaker Volume

Using this function, you can set the speaker volume

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Call Settings, press OK soft key
4. Press OK soft key to select Speaker Volume
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose the speaker volume level you want (up to 8 levels).
6. After the setting, press Back soft key to confirm and exit.

## Network Selection

This function allows you to choose a network when you are using an international roaming service whether by manual or by automatic selection. However, a roaming network is available to choose when your network provider has an agreement on roaming service with the roaming provider.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Network Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Network Select Mode, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\mathbf{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose Automatic Selection or Manual Selection, press OK soft key.

Charging the Mobile Phone (continued)
You can also plug the connector in the mini USB port on the phone directly to charge the mobile phone. Please refer to the figures on the right.

## Switching On/Off

## Switching On

Hold down key for 3 seconds or longer.
If no SIM card is inserted in the cellular phone, a message window that Insert SIM Card is displayed. In this case, only emergency call can be made and other functions cannot be used.


## Switching Off

Hold down 3 key for 3 seconds until the I icon appears on the LCD, then the display disappears

## Note:

Nothing will appear on the LCD when battery power is very low. YOU SHOULD fULLY CHARGE THE PHONE BEFORE USING.

## Basic Functions

## Making a Call

## Dialing

1. Enter a phone number in standby mode.
2. Press $\square$ key.

If you make a mistake, press Delete soft key to erase one digit at a time.
3. To end the call, press the key.

## Making a call from phone book

You can make a call using the phone book. For more details, please see par. Phone Book.

## Outgoing Call List

You can make a call using the outgoing call list.

1. Press $\quad \rightarrow$ key to display the outgoing call
list.
Or enter by accessing Menu -> Call Log ->
Outgoing Call.
2. Select desired number using $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key.
3. Press $\quad r$ key again.

For more details, refer to par. Outgoing Calls.

## Call Barring

Using this network service, you can limit incoming and outgoing calls from your phone.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Network Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Call Barring, press OK soft key.
5. The display shows the following options:

All Outgoing Calls: You cannot make an outgoing call from your phone.
All Incoming Call: You cannot receive an incoming call.
Incoming While Roam: You cannot receive an incoming call when you are not in a serviced area
Cancel All: Cancels all barring settings. You need to enter the Call-bar password (please contact with the service provider)
Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select one, press OK soft key.
6. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose among Check Status, Activate and Deactivate, press OK soft key. If you choose Activate, you need to enter the Call-bar password.
7. After all the setting, press OK soft key

## Call Forwarding

Using this function, you can divert incoming calls to a specified phone number.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Network Settings, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
4. Press $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Call Divert, press OK soft key
5. The display shows the following options:

Unconditional Divert: Configures call diverting to apply to all incoming calls.
Busy Divert: Diverts incoming calls to the specified number if your line is busy.
No Answer Divert: Diverts incoming calls to the specified number if you do not answer the call.
No Service/Power Off Divert: Diverts incoming calls to the specified number if your phone is turned off, not in a service area or unreachable for other reason.
Cancel All Divert: Releases all the call diverting settings.
Press $\boldsymbol{A}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select one, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
6. Use $\boldsymbol{\Lambda}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose among Check Status, Activate and Deactivate, press OK soft key. If you choose Activate, you need to enter a number to divert the incoming call to.
7. After all the setting, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.

## Speed Dial Memory

You can make a call using speed dial buttons.
If you have enable the speed dial function, you can also press one of M1~M3 buttons to dial out the matching number.

For more details, refer to par. Speed Dial.

## Receiving a Call

When there is an incoming call, the call's information will appear.

If a caller ID service is activated and if the incoming phone number is already stored in phone book, the name you have stored for this number is displayed.

1. To answer the call, press $\square$ key
2. You can speak. To hang up, press key.

Result: After you hang up, the LCD displays the call duration.

## Handsfree

During a call, you may turn on the speakerphone built in the handset. In this mode you can simply put your handset on a surface (e.g. a desk) and enjoy the comfort of the handsfree conversation.

To turn the feature on, press the Spk On soft key during a call (line engaged).

To turn the feature off, and keep on talking in normal mode, press the Spk Off soft key.

## Note:

- Before putting the phone near your ears, be sure you have turned the speakerphone off.


## Amplification Function

Your phone is equipped with a specialized amplification function designed to fit your needs. During a conversation you can use the $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{\vee}$ key and the AMP key on the right side to adjust the receiver volume. You can also press the Tone control on the left side of the phone repeatedly to fit the levels to your hearing requirements. The selected level will be displayed on the LCD (High Tone/Normel Tone/Low Tone).
When you press the AMP key in receiver mode during a conversation, the Amplifier indicator on the handset lights on. If you press the AMP key again, the indicator will go out.
CAUTION: This telephone can produce very high (loud) sound levels. Repeated incremental exposure to amplification levels greater than 18 dB may be harmful to people without hearing loss.

## Network Settings

Using this function, you can configure various network services. Before using this service, check available services from your service provider.

## Call Waiting

Using this function, you can activate or deactivate the call waiting function.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Network Settings, press OK soft key,
4. Press OK soft key to select Call Waiting.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose among Check Status, Activate and Deactivate, press OK soft key.
6. After the setting, press OK soft key again.

## Date \& Time Settings

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
3. Press $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Clock Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Press OK soft key again to select Date \& Time.
5. Use the numeric keypad to enter the current time, press $\mathbf{O K}$
6. Use the numeric keypad to enter the current date, press $\mathbf{O K}$

## Notes: <br> - At step 5 if you have selected 12 Hours in Time Format menu, you need to enter the time in a 12-hour format and select AM or PM, otherwise you should enter the time in a 24-hour format. <br> - At step 6 you should enter the current date in the format the system indicates you.

## Options During a Call

You can use a variety of functions during a call by pressing Option soft key.

## Mute/Unmute

You can turn off the microphone so that the caller on the other side cannot hear you.

## Disconnect

You can end the current call.

## Hold/Unhold

You can hold the current call.

## Main Menu

You can enter the main menu during a call.

## Menu Functions

## Menu Navigation

## To access a menu option

1. To display menu items, press Menu soft key.
2. To scroll through menu options, press or $\mathbf{V}$ key repeatedly.
3. To select a menu, press OK soft key when the desired menu appears on the LCD.
4. Repeat if necessary.

To return to Standby mode from any menu

If you press Back soft key from any menu, the phone returns to the previous screen.

To return to Standby mode from any menu, press the 0 key.

## Clock Settings

## Date Format

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Clock Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Date Format, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select among DD-MM-YY, MM-DD-YY, DD-MM-YYYY and MM-DD-YYYY, press OK to confirm.

## Time Format

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Press V key to select Clock Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Time Format, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select between $\mathbf{1 2}$ Hours and $\mathbf{2 4}$ Hours, press OK to confirm.

## Factory Default

If you choose to reset the handset to restore the initial settings, all the user selectable features are restored to the factory defaults:

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Press OK soft key again to select Phone Settings.
4. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Factory Default, press OK soft key.
5. You will be asked to enter the current Phone Code (the default code is 1234). Use the numeric keypad to enter the code and press OK soft key.

## SMS - Short Message Service

Using this function, you can write, send, receive, check and edit messages.

## Writing/Sending/Storing a new message

You can create a text message containing up to 160 alphanumeric characters and send it. To do this, proceed as follows:

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Press OK soft key again to select Write Message.
4. Enter the message text (up to 160 characters) using the alphanumeric keys. Press the \# key to switch between different inputting mode while press Delete soft key to edit it. Then press Option soft key to choose:
Only Send - To send the message without storing it in outbox.
Only Save - To store the message in the outbox folder without sending it.
Send And Save - To send the message and store it in outbox.
Insert Name - To insert a contact name in your message

## Keypad Locking

You can lock the keypad for your privacy. When the keypad is locked, icon appears.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Press OK soft key again to select Phone Settings.
4. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Keypad Locking Settings, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose the keylock time between $\mathbf{3 0}$ Seconds and $\mathbf{6 0}$ Seconds. You can also select Off to deactivate this function. Press OK soft key. If you activate this function, the keypad will be automatically locked after the time you have set if no key is pressed.
6. When the keypad is locked, press Unlock soft key then long press the \# key to unlock it.

## Change Phone Code

You can change your phone password.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.

6. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Change Phone Code, press OK soft key.
7. Enter the current Phone Code, press OK. Then enter the new code you want to use and press OK. Then enter the new code again to confirm and then press OK to save the setting. If the old password is correct and the two entering for new password is the same, the display will show Done! to complete the setting

Insert Number - To insert a contact number in your message.
If you have previously selected Only Send or Send And Save, enter the phone number to which you want to send the message by using the keypad, or press Search soft key to enter the phone book in order to choose a desired contact. Then press OK to confirm and send the message. When the message is being sent, the display shows Message Sent Successfully, or it shows Sending Failed followed by Message Sent Unsuccessfully. Retry?. You can press Retry soft key to send it again or press Cancel to quit.

## Inbox

The Inbox stores the messages you have received. You can forward, reply, delete, edit these messages or store the sender's number to your phone or SIM card. When a new short message is received, the LCD display shows 1 New Message, and you can press Select soft key to read it.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Inbox, press OK soft key.
4. Select the desired message by using $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key. If the message has been reviewed, it is marked with , otherwise it is marked with . Press OK soft key, the display will show the whole message.
5. You can access the following options by pressing Option:

Delete - To delete the selected message.
Text Reply - To send a reply to the selected message.
Forward - To send the received message to another person.
Edit - To edit the selected message.
Dial Back - To call the sender back.
Extract Number - To extract the sender's number and store it to the phone or SIM card.

## Security Settings

## SIM Lock

You can activate or deactivate SIM card lock function.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Press OK soft key again to select Phone Settings.
4. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Security Settings, press OK soft key.
5. You will be asked to enter the current Phone Code (the default code is 1234). Use the numeric keypad to enter the code and then press OK soft key.
6. Press OK key again to select Power On PIN1.
7. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose $\mathbf{O N}$ or OFF, press OK soft key. You can also select Change PIN1 to modify it.
8. If you choose ON, you will need to enter the PIN1 code after switching on the phone. Then you can use it. Please note that if you enter the wrong PIN for three times, the phone will prompt you to enter the PUK code.

## Date Time Display

The LCD display will show the time in standby mode if you have activated this function.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.

## Outbox \& Sent Fail Box

The Outbox stores successfully sent and saved messages while the Sent fail box stores saved messages which are sent unsuccessfully.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Outbox or Sent Fail Box, press OK soft key.
4. Select the desired message by using $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key. The display will show the whole message.
5. You can access the following options by pressing Option:

Delete - To delete the selected message.
Forward - To send the selected message to another person.
Edit - To edit the selected message.
Dial Back - To call the recipients back.
Extract Number - To extract the recipients' number and store it to the phone or SIM card.

## Draftbox

The Draftbox stores messages which you select Only Save option after editing.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Draftbox, press OK soft key.
4. Select the desired message by using $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key. The display will show the whole message.
5. You can access the following options by pressing Option:

Delete - To delete the selected message
Forward - To send the selected message to another person.
Edit - To edit the selected message.
3. Press OK soft key again to select Phone Settings.
4. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Display Settings, press OK soft key
5. Press OK soft key to select LCD Contrast.
6. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose among the 20 available contrast levels then press OK soft key.

## LCD Backlight

The phone features a backlight LCD that is illuminated whenever you touch a key, place the phone on the charger or remove the phone from the charger. You can adjust the backlight time.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Press OK soft key again to select Phone Settings.
4. Press $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Display Settings, press OK soft key.
5. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Backlight, press OK soft key.
6. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select among Always On, Always Off, 15 Seconds On and 30 Seconds On, then press OK soft key.

## Phone Settings

## Language

You can change the language used to display the menu messages. There are 8 different languages for selection, English, Russian, Spanish, Swedish, Dutch, Portuguese, French and German. You can also select Auto select option, then the phone will select a language automatically.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
3. Press OK soft key again to select Phone Settings.
4. Press OK soft key to select Language
5. Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select the language you want and then press $\mathbf{O K}$ to confirm

## Contrast

The adjustment allows you to optimize the way items appear on the display by changing the contrast according to the environmental conditions.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key

## Delete

You can delete messages in the Inbox, Sentbox, Outbox, Draftbox or all the messages stored.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{A}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Delete All, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
4. Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose Delete All Messages, Delete Inbox Messages, Delete Outbox Messages, Delete Sent Fail Box Messages or Delete Draftbox Messages according to your necessary. The phone will prompt you to check. Press OK to confirm or press Cancel to quit.

## Service Center

To enable the SMS feature you should ask your service supplier the service centre numbers and store it in your phone as below:

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Press OK soft key to choose Service Center
5. Enter the service center number (up to 20 digits), then press OK soft key. The display shows Done!.

## Validity Period

Set the validity period of the message you are sending. If it run over time and the message is still sent unsuccessfully, it will not be sent again.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose Validity Period, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select among 1 Hour, 12 Hours, 24 Hours, 1 Week, 1 Month, $\mathbf{3}$ Months and Maximum, then press OK soft key. The display shows Done!
6. Press OK soft key again to choose Set/Edit, then you can press the Delete key to clear the digits then enter the desired ones, press OK to confirm.

## Deleting a Speed Dial Number

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Set M1/M2/M3, press OK soft key.
3. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select the desired position M1, M2 or M3, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
4. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Delete, press OK soft key to clear this number.

## Speed Dial

There are 3 speed dial buttons (M1~M3) for frequently used numbers, each number can be up to 20 digits.

## Storing Speed Dial Numbers

2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Set M1/M2/M3, press OK soft key.
3. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select the desired position M1, M2 or M3, press OK soft key.
4. Press OK soft key again, then enter a number that you want to use, press OK to save.

## Dialing Speed Dial Numbers

After the setting, you can press M1, M2 or M3 in standby mode, then press OK to dial out the corresponding number.

## Editing a Speed Dial Number

## Status Report

If you have activated this feature, after sending a message, the system will report whether the sent message was delivered or not.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose Status Report, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select $\mathbf{O n}$ to activate this function or select $\mathbf{O f f}$ to deactivate it, then press OK soft key.
On: Reports whether or not the sent message was delivered
Off: Does not report whether or not the sent message was delivered.

## Reply Path

If you have activated this feature, which is often used in reverse charging, when replying a message, you can use the setting of the other party's SMS service center number.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose Reply Path, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select $\mathbf{O n}$ to activate this function or select $\mathbf{O f f}$ to deactivate it, then press OK soft key.

## Call Duration

Displays the duration of selected calls including received and dialed.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Call Log, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Call Duration, press OK soft key.
4. The LCD display shows Outgoing Duration, Incoming Duration and Last Call Duration. Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to scroll through, you can also press Reset soft key to clear them or press Back to quit.

## Missed Call

When you have a missed call, the message $\mathbf{x}$ Missed Call(s) appears on the display. For example: $\mathbf{2}$ Missed Call(s). Press Select soft key to review the details or press Back to cancel. You can also review missed calls in Call Log menu as follows:

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Call Log, press OK soft key
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Missed Call, press OK soft key.
4. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to scroll through the list until you find the desired number, press Select soft key. You can review call's information such as phone number, calling date and time. If you have stored the caller's number in phone book, caller's name will be displayed.
5. Press Option soft key to display the following options:

Dial - To dial this number out.
Send Message - To send a short message to the selected number.
Delete - To delete the selected number.
Save Number - To save this number in your phone book.
Delete All - To delete all the numbers in missed calls list.
Show Number - To show the selected missed calls number.

## Storage Medium

You can set the short message storage mode. If you select SIM Preferred option, when you receive a new short message, it will be stored in SIM card by default. When the memory of SIM card is full, new messages will be stored in the phone. Otherwise new messages will be stored in the phone firstly.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Settings, press OK soft key.
4. Press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to choose Storage Medium, press OK soft key.
5. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select SIM Preferred or ME Preferred, then press OK soft key. The display shows Done!.

## Storage Status

You can check the number of messages stored in the SIM card and the phone.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Storage Status, press OK soft key.
4. You can view the current message memory status. For example, SIM Total:40, SIM Used:13, ME Total:20, ME Used:0. Press OK soft key to quit.

## Outgoing Calls

Displays phone numbers of dialed calls you made.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Call Log, press OK soft key.
3. Press $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Outgoing Call, press $\mathbf{O K}$ soft key.
4. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to scroll through the list until you find the desired number, press Select soft key. You can review call's information such as phone number (or name), the date and time.
5. Press Option soft key to display the following options:

Dial - To dial this number out.
Send Message - To send a short message to the selected number.
Delete - To delete the selected number.
Save Number - To save this number in your phone book.
Delete All - To delete all the numbers in outgoing calls list.
Show Number - If you have store this number in phone book, the list will show the name only, select this option to show the calls number.

## Call Log

Using this function, you can check recent calls you made, calls received and missed calls.

## Incoming Calls

Displays phone numbers of calls you have answered

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Call Log, press OK soft key.
3. Press OK soft key to select Incoming Call.
4. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to scroll through the list until you find the desired number, press Select soft key. You can review call's information such as phone number, calling date and time. If you have stored the caller's number in phone book, caller's name will be displayed.
5. Press Option soft key to display the following options:

Dial - To dial this number out
Send Message - To send a short message to the selected number.
Delete - To delete the selected number.
Save Number - To save this number in your phone book.
Delete All - To delete all the numbers in incoming calls list.
Show Number - To show the selected incoming calls number.

## Voice Mail

Using this function, you can listen to your voice mail if someone leaves a voice mail to you.

## Mailbox number setting

You need to set the mailbox number before receiving a voice mail.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Voice Mail, press OK soft key.
4. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Mailbox Number, press OK soft key.
5. Enter the mailbox number using the numeric keypad and then press $\mathbf{O K}$ to confirm.

## Listen to Voice mail

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press OK soft key to select Message.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Voice Mail, press OK soft key.
4. Press OK soft key to select Listen To Voice Mail Messages.

## Phone Book

You can store phone numbers and name in the phone book and retrieve to make a call. Data can be stored both in SIM card and your cellular phone.
Note that the maximum amount of data stored depends on the type of SIM card.

## Storing Phone Book Entries

You can store phone book entries by using the phone book menu or in standby mode.

## Way 1: by using the phone book menu

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Phonebook, press OK soft key.
3. Press $\boldsymbol{\vee}$ key to select Add New, press OK soft key.
4. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select Save To SIM or Save To ME, press OK soft key.
5. Press Option soft key then press OK soft key to select Detail/Edit option. Enter a name that you want to use (up to 14 characters), press OK soft key. Please refer to the Character Map.
6. Press $V$ key to move to number field, press Option soft key then press OK soft key to select Detail/Edit option. Enter the appropriate number (up to 40 digits), press OK soft key.
7. After the setting, press Option soft key then select Save option, press OK soft key, the LCD display shows Done!.

## Copy/Deleting all the Phone Book Entries

You can delete all the phonebook entries or copy all the entries between the phone and SIM card.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode.
2. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Phonebook, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Copy All or Delete All, press OK soft key.
4. If you select Copy All, you can select between From SIM Card To Phone and From Phone To SIM Card. If you select Delete All, you can select between Delete All ME and Delete All SIM. Press OK, the phone will prompt you to check the deletion. Press OK to confirm or press Cancel to quit.

## Storage Status

You can check the number of the phonebook entries stored in SIM card and the phone.

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Press V key to select Phonebook, press OK soft key.
3. Repeatedly press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Storage Status, press OK soft key.
4. You can view the current phone book memory status. For example, SIM Total:250, SIM Used:4, ME Total:40, ME Used:0.

## Using Phone Book Entries Options

You can edit, delete, copy or move an entry between the phone and SIM card. You can also send a message to the number you select.

1. Find the desired entry in the phone book.
2. Press Option soft key. Then press $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to choose the desired option:

Search - To search for phonebook entries.
Dial - To dial out the selected entry number.
Send Message - To send a short message to the number of this entry.
Detail/Edit - To view the details or edit the selected entry.
Extract Number - To extract and store the number to SIM or the phone.
Delete - To delete the selected phonebook entry.
Add New - To add a new phone book entry.
Storage Status - To check the number of phonebook entries stored in SIM card and the phone.

## Notes

- In step 5, to switch among upper, lower case and digit mode, press the \# key while entering
the text.
- If you make a mistake while entering a number or a name, use Delete soft key to delete the
last character. You can also use the $\mathbf{\wedge}$ or $\vee$ keys to move on to other incorrect characters last character. You can also use the $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or


## Way 2: in standby mode

1. Enter a phone number while in standby mode and then press Save.
2. Use $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to select among Save To SIM, Save To ME and Save To Existed Record, press OK
3. Complete the storing of the entry by starting from step 5 described in Way 1 .

## Reviewing/Dialing a Number in Phone Book

You can search the entries stored in the phone book by entering the first character of their name (alphabetic search). You can also scroll through the whole list of the phone book entries in phone book menu.

## Way 1: alphabetic search

1. Press Menu soft key in standby mode
2. Press $\mathbf{V}$ key to select Phonebook, press OK soft key.
3. Press OK soft key again to select Search.
4. You can press Option soft key then press OK soft key to select Search option. Enter the first letter of the name by using the alphanumeric keys, press OK soft key. All the entries ahead with this letter appears. Repeatedly press the $\boldsymbol{\Lambda}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to move to the desired one.

## Way 2: searching by scrolling the phone book list

1. Perform steps 1 to 3 of Way 1.
2. Repeatedly press the $\boldsymbol{\wedge}$ or $\boldsymbol{V}$ key to move to the desired entry.
3. Press Option then select Detail/Edit option to view the details or edit the selected entry. You can also select Dial option or press the $\square$ key to dial this number out.
