# 1. Regulatory instruction of usage

- Before using the terminal, please check the does it has been disassembled, modified, or happened the abnormal situation. If yes, please do not continue to use.
- Please stay away from strong electromagnetic waves.
   (Example) Microwave ovens, magnets, shoplifting prevention devices, high-voltage wires, automatic doors, communication antennas, etc.
- Condensation can occur when moving from a cold place to a warm place. If condensation occurs, do not use the unit until the connected water droplets evaporate.
- Static electricity may occur in some places (such as where you are using a carpet).
- Please do not leave it in the sun for a long time.
- Please operate the unit carefully as it is a precision instrument. Do not apply impact, drop or heavy objects on top of the unit.
- Do not attach dust, oil, etc. to a part of the power terminal. Also, please do not scratch.
- Warning: Power cord shall be connected to a socket-outlet with earthing connection.
- The equipment is intended to be supplied by external power source (UL listed/ IEC 60950-1/ IEC 62368-1) which output complies with SELV, LPS, output rating 5Vdc, 2A, ambient temperature min. 40°C.

#### 2.2. Insert Battery



Step 1: Remove the battery cover.

Step 2: Insert the battery into the compartment.

Step 3: Reverse the operation of step 1 to install the battery cover.

Note: Please confirm the battery is installed before power on the terminal.

#### 2.3. Insert SAM Card

Step 1: Remove battery cover / back cover

Step 2: Insert SAM card into desire slot.

SAM 1 & 2:

Gold contact is on the upper side of the card and facing down.

Step 3: Reverse the operation of step 1 to install the battery cover.

#### 2.4. Insert GSM Micro SIM Card

Step 1: Remove battery cover / back cover

Step 2: Insert GSM Micro SIM card into desire slot.

SIM 1:

Cut corner is on the upper left side of card and facing down.

SIM 2:

Cut corner is on the lower right side of card and facing down.

Step 3: Reverse the operation of step 1 to install the battery cover.

#### 2.5. Insert Memory card

- Step 1: Remove battery cover / back cover
- Step 2: Place Micro SD memory card.

Step 3: Reverse the operation of step 1 to install the battery cover.

# 3. Basic Operation

Once the power is on in normal status, the terminal will enter Launcher if no default application selected. All user applications are listed in the launcher. Users can click on an application and run the application. Castles provide applications "System Panel" and "loader" for development use.

#### 3.1. Main Screen

On the terminal, it provides some features for developers, and also have the simple symbols let users know the feature situation (e.g. internet, battery... etc.)



## 3.2. System Panel

The developer can use the system panel to set system settings and check system versions.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [System Panel].

#### 3.3. Loader

Download user application, or update Android system and kernel modules firmware.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [loader].

#### 3.4. Test Utility

Diagnose terminal hardware components.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [Test Utility].

#### 3.5. POS Demo

Test EMV/EMVCL function and demo use.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [POS Demo].

#### 3.6. Setting

View/set the wireless & network, device configure, personal configure, system information on the terminal.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [Setting]

Note: The actual Steps are: Select Settings > About Phone > Certification

## 3.7. Snapdragon Camera

Users can use the rear camera or barcode scanner to snap the photo. Note: This SnapDragon Camera is intended for internal use only.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [Snapdragon Camera]

#### 3.8. Gallery

View all of the snap photos on the terminal.

Note: This Gallery is intended for internal use only.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [Gallery]

#### 3.9. CTMS

Connect to Castles terminal management server and management the terminals update schedule.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [CTMS]

#### 3.10.Key Bridge

The customize feature, only provide for the specify customer to use.



- Click on [App menu].
- Click on [Key\_Bridge]

# 4. Secure File Loading

Castles implemented an interface in terminal named User Loader (ULD) to provide secure file loading to system memory. The Loader only applies to download the "CAP" file for the user application and the kernel firmware.

The loading process is secure by signing the files using ULD Key System.

#### 4.1. File Signing

For convert the file to "CAP" file, Castles provides a tool named "CAPGen" to perform this task.

The CAPGen is located at:

C:\Program Files (x86)\Castles\SATURN1000\tools\CAPG (Evaluation Version)\
