

# 3. Charging

#### 5. Basic Operations

#### 5.1 Headset on / off

Turn on the headset – Pres and hold the MFB for 2 seconds until blue LED

Turn off the headset – Press and hold the MFB for 3 seconds until red LED

Please Note: To save power, the headset will automatically turn off if it is not connected to any device for more than 10 minutes.

- 5.2 Answer a call press the MFB briefly to pick up the call.
- 5.3 Reject a call press and hold the MFB for 2 seconds.
