- 1) The User Manual exhibit (page 6 of 22) appears to indicate the DMS-02 transmits a signal to a partner DMS-02 sensor when an alarm is activated:

**Note:** When more than one sensor strip is used on a door, when an alarm is activated a wireless signal is automatically sent to activate its partner sensor strip having the same door ID code. This ensures that both monitors activate when protecting the same door, or area.

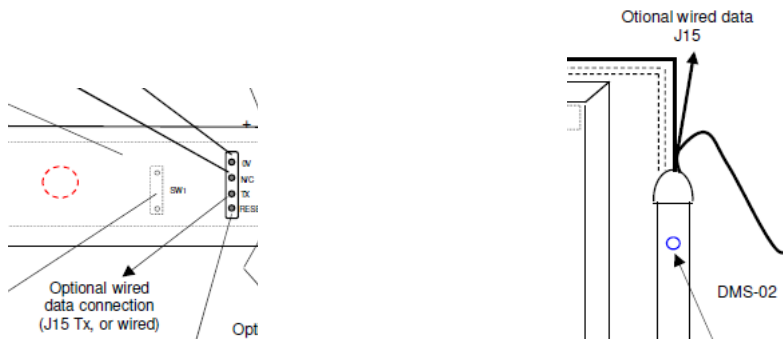
Please clarify if the DMS-02 unit has a transmitter.
