

Operation Description

The MCS-720 is a fully supervised wireless siren, for indoor use, that communicates with PowerMax Pro or PowerMaxComplete alarm system.

The siren is activated according to specific commands that are transmitted from the alarm system (refer to the alarm system specifications - SIREN SIGNALS).

The siren is activated for a predefined "Bell Time" (refer to PowerMax Pro / PowerMaxComplete installer guide, par. 4.4), according to local authorities requirements, or until the system is disarmed, whichever occurs first.

When an identified activation command is received from the alarm system, the strobe light is activated every 1 second (100ms ON, 900ms OFF) for a period of 20 minutes maximum, or until the alarm system is disarmed whichever occurs first.

Upon pressing the self test switch more than 3 seconds, the siren performs a functionality check during which low level piezo sounds and flash lights indicate that the siren is fully operational.
