The E203826 ZigBee transceiver FCC ID: WP3ZBT and label is so small (2cm x 2 cm) that it cannot include the statement specified in FCC Part 15 Sub-part A, Section 15.19 (a) (3)

“This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:

- (1) This device may not cause harmful interference and
- (2) This device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.”

The unit is so small that the FCC label cannot appear on the device itself and the label appears in all host user manuals.
