


Using Your SoundCLIP

Power On/Off



Pairing

[Note] The SoundCLIP is set to be in Bluetooth pairing mode automatically when turned on for the first time. Put your mobile phone in pairing mode prior to turning on your SoundCLIP. The instructions that follow are for placing the SoundCLIP into pairing mode manually

Pair with Bluetooth Phone



1. Slide up the power button while holding down the Multi-function Button in power off mode.
2. You will hear two beeps while the blue lights blink.
3. Refer to your mobile phone manual's Bluetooth Phone section and choose "Compatible Devices". The mobile phone's menu may differ by component. After reading the manual and mobile phone menu components, execute the stereo headset search function.
4. Select SoundCLIP and connect.
5. When prompted for a Pin Code, type '0000', then Pairing is completed.

Pair with a Bluetooth MP3 Player (Stereo Dongle) and Phone

[Note] The SoundCLIP enables you to remain connected to your mobile phone and listen to music from a separate MP3 player with Bluetooth capability (stereo dongle) using Bluetooth's Multipoint capability.

1. Connect the SoundCLIP to your MP3 player (dongle)
 - a) With the SoundCLIP power off, slide up the power button while pressing down the Multi-function Button.
 - b) You will hear two beeps from the SoundCLIP while the blue lights blink.
 - c) Refer to the MP3 Player (Dongle) manual and change the mode to Pairing mode.
 - d) Establish connection when the SoundCLIP is detected by the MP3 Player (dongle).
 - e) If prompted by the MP3 player, when the Pin Code screen appears, insert '0000'. Pairing is completed., Note: The Pin Code step may not be required for some dongles.
2. Re-Connect your mobile phone to your SoundCLIP. It is recommended that you pair your mobile phone with the SoundCLIP first by following the pairing instructions above. Find your "Compatible Devices" menu screen on your mobile phone and select the SoundCLIP and connect to it.
3. The two products are now connected in synchronization.

■ Important: If pairing is successful, blue LED blinks twice every five seconds, otherwise blue LED blinks once every five seconds.

How to Play Music

■ Play Music

Mode	Description
Play/ Pause	Press Multi-function Button + Volume Up or Down simultaneously
Stop	Press Multi-function Button + Volume Up or Down simultaneously for 2 seconds
Skip to prev. song	Hold down Volume Down for 2 seconds
Skip to next song	Hold down Volume Up for 2 seconds
Fast Rewind	Hold down Volume Down for longer than 3 seconds
Fast forward	Hold down Volume Up for longer than 3 seconds
Volume Control	Press Volume Up or Down button

Using the Phone

■ Making Call

Mode	Description
Sending/Receiving/Ending Calls	Press Multi-function Button lightly once.
Switch to Speaker phone or vice versa	Hold down Multi-function Button for 2 seconds during call
Redialing the previous number	On standby mode, press Multi-function Button lightly
Returning the call received	On standby mode, press Volume Up + Down
Voice Dialing	On standby mode, hold down Multi-function Button for 2 seconds
Rejecting Call	During incoming call, hold down Multi-function Button for 2 seconds
Mute On Microphone	Hold down Volume Up or Down for 2 seconds during call
Mute Off Microphone	Hold down Volume Up or Down lightly.

How to answer a Call while listening to music

- The music will stop automatically and the SoundCLIP will ring with the incoming call.
- Press once and release the Multi-function Button to answer the call.
- When the call ends, the music resumes automatically.

How to reject a Call while listening to music

- Press and Hold the Multi-function Button for more than 2 seconds.
- If you are using a normal audio dongle, Play/ Stop/ Fast Forward/ Fast Rewind function may be limited.

How to change ring tones

While the SoundCLIP is power on in standby mode, hold down Volume button (Up or Down) for 3 seconds to hear a beep followed by a ring tone. Depending on your preference, you can choose from different ring tones by pressing Volume button (Up or Down). The last ring tone you hear will be set as your ring tone.

[Note] A phone with built-in ring tone support may not support a selected ring tone.

How to set a receiving call to the TTS(Text-To-Speech) mode


The SoundCLIP comes with the TTS mode enabled. To cancel the TTS mode, hold down the Multi-function Button for 3 seconds and you will hear a high pitch sound. To enable the TTS mode, hold down the Multi-function Button for 3 seconds until you hear a high pitch sound.

Call Checking

- a) How to check last received call using TTS mode
Keep pressing Volume Up and Down button for 2 seconds
- b) Missed Call Reminder Function
When there is a missed call, a high pitch reminder tone rings every 10 seconds. To cancel the reminder sound function, press Multi-function Button or Volume (Up or Down) button.

How to use earphone

For additional flexibility, you can plug a mono or stereo earphone into the product's connection socket. After connection, the internal speakers will automatically mute.
