The acWAP is a non-consumer device that is only sold to airlines under contractual terms that contain non-disclosure of confidential information. Representative language can be found in Section 13 (pages 28-30) of the contract appended to the Theory of Operation.

In additional to above mentioned documents, pursuant to Public Notice DA 04-1705 of the Commission's policy, in order to comply with the marketing regulations in 47 CFR §2.803 and the importation rules in 47 CFR §2.1204, while ensuring that business sensitive information remains confidential until the actual marketing of newly authorized devices.
