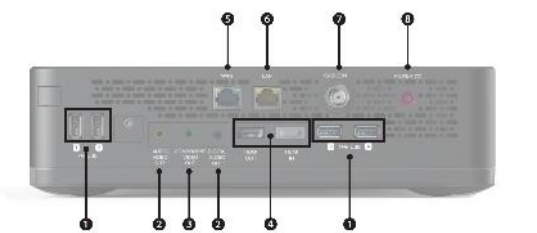
1.1 Front Panel

1.2 Rear Panel



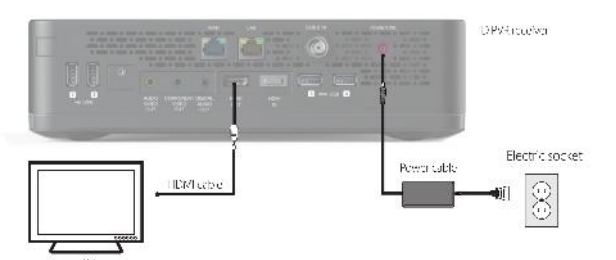
1	USB	Connect to USB Mass storage device for SW upgrade.

2. Installation Steps

You can install this receiver as per the following installation steps. If you have some questions regarding installation, please consult your ROVI customer care (1-800-333-3333).

2.1 Connecting HDMI cable / Connecting Power cable

1. Connect the receiver to a TV with HDMI jack. If your TV is equipped for it.
2. Connect it to the power outlet. It is provided as well as in portable socket.



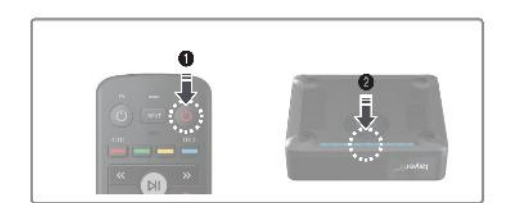
HDMI or high definition multimedia interface is a non-generation interface that enables the transmission of digital audio and video signals using a single cable without compression. Multimedia interface is more accurate than for regular because it allows multiple channels of digital audio (5.1 channels). When connecting via HDMI, you do not need to connect Audio Cables. You only need to connect Audio cables when connecting via HDMI/DVI.

2.2 Connecting the Antenna

Connect one end of the antenna cable to the ANT IN on the back of the receiver and the other end to a terrestrial antenna connection or the jack for the public antenna on the wall.

2.3 Turning On and Off Your Receiver

- Power On**
1. Press the STANDBY button on the remote control.
 2. The receiver will use up On.



- Power Off**
1. Press the STANDBY button on the remote control.
 2. The receiver will use up Off.

Installation notice

If you do not get a good picture or sound when watching pay per view programs, connect the setup box to the TV set. Do not connect it through a PC.
