
2. Installation Steps

You can install this receiver as per the following installation steps. If you have some questions regarding installation, please consult your 08008 DOLCE (08008 36523).

2.1 Connecting HDMI cable

Connect the receiver to a TV with HDMI jack, if your TV is equipped for it.






HDMI, or high-definition multimedia interface, is a next-generation interface that enables the transmission of digital audio and video signals using a single cable without compression. "Multimedia interface" is a more accurate name for it especially because it allows multiple channels of digital audio (5.1 channels). When connecting via HDMI, you do not need to connect Audio Cables. You only need to connect Audio cables when connecting via HDMI/DVI.

2.2 Connecting the Antenna

Connect one end of the antenna cable to the ANT IN on the back of the receiver and the other end to a terrestrial antenna connection or the jack for the public antenna on the wall.

2.3 Connecting Power cable

Connect the Power cable with the receiver as well as the electric socket.



2.4 Turning On and Off Your Receiver



Power On/Off

Press the **STANDBY** button on the front of the receiver or on the remote control.

2.5 Connecting other equipments

2.5.1 Connecting Audio & Video cable

If you have Audio cable and Video cable (CVBS or YPbPr), you can watch TV by connecting them with TV and the receiver.

2.5.2 Connecting the receiver with VCR

You can connect the receiver with VCR by using Scart cable or Audio & Video cable.

2.5.3 Connecting the receiver with Audio System

You can connect the receiver with Audio System by using audio cable.
