1. Please explain why 802.11g/n SAR testing was excluded. The conducted power for both is much higher than for 802.11b (far greater than 1/4dB).	<p>According to KDB 648474 D01, the standalone SAR for 802.11b, 802.11g and 802.11n is not required because the maximum output power of WLAN is less than P_{REF} and the distance to other antenna is 4.8cm (\cong 5cm).</p> <p>Please find the updated SAR report.</p> <p>On page 33/102, please see the Note: 1 and 2 state SAR test for 802.11b/g/n is not required and 802.11b SAR test is just for reference.</p>
