I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) This filing contains data relevant to two models of product one with and one without detachable antennas. Are both antennas the same gain? And what are the RF connectors used with the detachable antenna product?
- 2.) Please provide larger and clearer internal photographs. They are supposed to be clear enough to read the part designators on the ICs.
- 3.) Please provide an original artwork line drawing for the label. I am unable to see the FCC ID or the required 15.19(a)(3) statement on the product label as presented.
- 4.) Please review pages 12 and 13 of the Manual. Product with channeling which can be region-selected is not permitted in either USA or Canada. The end user cannot be given any method to set this equipment to channels outside of the designated bands.
- 5.) Please review all your spectrum image plots. The plots presented are shown as either 3 or 6 plots to a page. By the time these pages are turned into \*.pdf files, they are very difficult, if not impossible, to read. For example, please review pages 6-2 through 6-5: you can surely see the plots are not easily readable, especially for critical annotation like RBW,VBW, sweep time, marker, etc. Kindly take the time to create clearer and more readable plots with all your applications.
- 6.) FYI: FCC prefers to have all MPE estimations as a separate file, and not simply incorporated into the existing test report. For the future, please consider loading all MPE estimations as a separate document to the RF Exposure folder at the ATCB website.
