Friis Formula

Friis transmission formula: $Pd = (Pout^{*}G)/(4^{*}pi^{*}r^{2})$

Where

 $Pd = power density in mW/cm^{2}$

Pout = output power to antenna in mW

G = gain of antenna in linear scale

Pi = 3.1416

R = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd id the limit of MPE, 1 mW/cm². If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.

Software provided by client enabled the EUT to transmit and receive data at lowest, middle and highest channel individually.

The temperature and related humidity: 18° C and 78° RH.

The power density Pd (4th column) at a distance of 20 cm calculated from the Friis transmission formula is far below the limit of 1 mW/cm^2 .
