





How to create share device with other users

2. Choose "Add Sharing", Input email or Phone number of the person you want to share the frame in the Account field. Select "Done" in the end.

Note:He or She will be notified in their Smart App After the device successfully shared. The WiFi Frame will appear as a shared device on the main Screen and the person will able to share Photos or Videos by following the instructions in "How to share photos/videos to the frame from your phone" Section.



How to remove a frame from "eco4life" app
