Here assuming a worst-case prediction of power density (100% reflection), then  $S = 4PG / (4\pi R^2) = PG / (\pi R^2)$ .

Where  $S = power density in mW/cm^2$ 

P = transmit power in mW

G = numeric gain of transmit antenna

R = distance (cm)

As we can see from the test report SH09041141-001:

The maximum P = 22.90 dBm = 194.98 mW

G = 1.80dBi = 1.51

Here R is chosen to be 20cm,

 $S = PG / (\pi R^2) = 194.98 * 1.51 / (3.14 * 20 * 20) = 0.23 mW/cm^2$ 

This level is below the 1 mW/cm<sup>2</sup> MPE for General Population / Uncontrolled Exposure as stated in OET BULLETIN 65 Edition 97-01.

Conclusion: this EUT fulfills 47CFR Part 15.247(i) (2007) with the definition outlined in the User's Manual. (See appendix I)

## Appendix I

## **Definition below must be outlined in the User Manual:**

- 1. The installed antennas must not be located in a manner that allows exposure of the general population at a distance of less than 20cm.
- 2. Mount the antennas in a manner that prevents any personnel from entering the area within 20cm from the central position of the antenna.
