# **Installation & Usage Statements**

- 1. Power supply: DC12V, do NOT install this product in trucks or buses with 24V batteries
- 2. Do NOT use it in high temperature and humid environment for long time to avoid faults or dangers
- 3. The navigation function (parking camera is optional) is only an assistant when you are driving, so do NOT distract, be careless or lose judgement during your driving
- 4. If this system distracts your attention during your driving, please do NOT use it to ensure abiding by safe driving regulations and prevailing traffic regulations
- 5. Please ensure the vehicle engine is started before this system is activated, otherwise, its battery will consume
- 6. This product provides a touch screen, so any touch-pen or ball pen with damaged pen point, or sharp article may scratch or damage the screen; please use touch-pen with intact pen point; if any broken pen point, do NOT use it again.

### [Warning]

Do NOT install or maintain the navigation on your own. Anyone who gets no training on eletronic devices or car accessories may suffer from eletric shock or other dangers.

## **Product Overview**

3G vehicle multimedia navigation is a vehicle-mounted product integrating eletronics, communication and embedded technology and bringing people, vehicle and environment much closer. It uses WinCE 6.0 operation platform and could customize user interface fast based on Silverlight interface development technology; its HD LED panel and smart original steering wheel control help you drive without troubles even hands holding on the steering wheel and diverting your eyesight; up to 800MHz main frequency allows you a better dynamic touch screen.

## Power ON & OFF

Turn ACC on vehicle to ON (start the engine) to start the machine and the panel shows the main interface Turn ACC to OFF (shut down the engine) to stop the power

### **Power ON**

If remove the key to turn the navigation off last time, please insert the key to start it this time; If press the button on the panel to turn the navigation off last time, please press the key to start it this time

### **Power OFF**

Remove the key and the system will recognize power disconnection and shut down Long press the button for at least 2s and the system will shut down

### Reboot

If any delay or stay in image switch or no activation after clicking to perform, click "Reset" on panel to reboot the system

Notes: please start the vehicle engine before starting this navigation; otherwise its battery will be consumed.


## Radio


Click "USB" sign on main interface to enter the USB play interface, shown in the following picture:

- 3. Sign " enter JEPG folder interface
- 4. Sign "<sup>1</sup>": mute/not mute
- 5. Sign "<sup>1</sup><sup>1</sup><sup>1</sup>": enter the sound effect regulation interface (such "classic, jazz, rock, original, popular, soft, customized")
- 6. Sign "<sup>(IIII)</sup>": play the previous audio file/video file/picture
- 7. Sign "<sup>1</sup>": pause/play
- 8. Sign: "🕑 ": play the next audio/video/picture



If "please do NOT watch videos or pictures while driving for the sake of your safety" shows on the interface when you are watching videos or pictures, please return to the main interface and setting interface to shut "NO videos during driving"








- 1. Sign "Sign ": previous month

## **General Setting**

#### **Background Scene**

Click " **Solution**" in "background scene" to set the background style; click "return" to save and return to the main interface after the setting

### **Screen Brightness**

Click " in "screen brightness" to regulate; click "return" to save and return to the main interface after the setting

### **BEEP Volume**

Click "ON" or "OFF" in "BEEP volume" to set; click "return" to save and return to the main interface after the setting

### Video over Driving

Click "ON" or "OFF" in "video over driving" to set; click "return" to save and return to the main interface after the setting

#### **Restore Default**

Click "restore default setting" in "restore default" and then "OK"; click "return" to save and return to the main interface after the setting

### **Touch-screen Calibration**

If the touched position on screen deviates from the actual position, click "touch-screen calibration" to calibrate under instructions; click "return" to save and return to the main interface after the setting. (if the image deviates or blurs, even cannot be recognized, long press "menu" on the panel to start "touch-screen calibration")

Notes: slide free on the setting interface to pop out other settings

#### Sound Effect

Click "sound effect" sign to enter the sound effect setting interface; "classic, jazz, rock, original, popular, soft or customized" and "Bass ON or OFF" are available; click "return" to return the main interface after the setting, shown as the following picture:

### Menu signs

- 1. Sign " 🔯 ": bass ON
- 2. Sign " **m**": bass OFF
- 3. Sign " Sound ": switch "classic, jazz, rock, original, popular, soft or customized"

### Balance

Click "balance" sign to enter the balance setting interface; set "left, right, front & back" sound balance; click "restore factory setting" if it's wanted; click "return" to return to the main interface after the setting.

\* Notes: Navione folder in SD card has navigation programs, so please do NOT delete any files inside to avoid navigation program exceptions. Click navigation sign on the main interface to pop out a prompt interface, and then click "OK" to enter the map interface. Click "Function" on navigation interface and then select "Turn OFF"; a prompt box will pop out and click "OK" to shut down the system. Please read User Manual on Navigation Software if you want more operations.


