1. Product Overview



2.Charging

- · Use the Micro USB cable to connect the power input jack of charging case and adapter. White indicator light will flash when charging, and the white indicator light will always be on after
- Put the headset into the charging case. Red indicator light will turn on when charging, and turn off after full charge. It takes 1~ 2 hours to fully charge the battery.

- (1) The headset will be turned off when it is charging.
- (2) Charging time is recommended not exceed 3 hours.

3.Pairing

- . For the first time, press and hold the MFB for 3 seconds to turn on the headset, then will hear prompt voice "DE" intermittently in 5 mins, red and blue indicator light will flash alternately ,it get into the pairing mode.
- Activate the Bluetooth function of the mobile phone, and scan the Bluetooth device. (For the Bluetooth instruction, please refer the manual of mobile phone)
- Choose "V1" from the searched device list.
- · Connection success with voice prompt "connected" . The Bluetooth device list of the phone is shown as below :



Note:

- 1.Please enter "0000" (4 zeros), if your phone need Bluetooth PIN code.
- 2.The Bluetooth headset will automatically pairing with the paired device when it is turned on.
- 3.Double click MFB to switch the prompt language when it is turned on.(Chinese/English).
