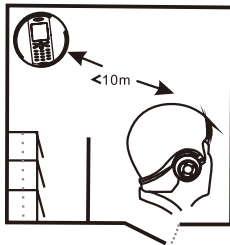
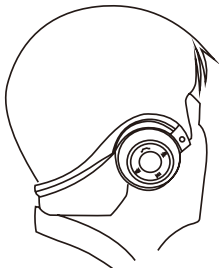

Get Started

Prior to use your BH-501 Stereo Bluetooth headset, please follow the steps below,

1. Ensure your Bluetooth headset is fully charged.
2. Pair your Bluetooth headset with the Bluetooth-enabled mobile phone.

Charge Your Headset

Charge the headset through the charged socket from charger or PC via charge cable, the battery indicator is red when charging, and shuts down automatically after fully charged.

Turn on/off the headset

To turn the headset on, press and hold the MFB for 2 seconds until "Power On" prompt is heard.

About pairing function, please refer to "Pair Your Headset".

To turn the headset off, press and hold the MFB for approximately 3 seconds until the "Power Off" prompt, and the indicator flashes red and shut down.

Warm Prompt: If your headset is inactive, it is suggested to turn the headset and the Bluetooth function of your mobile phone as well.

Pair Your Headset

The headset works with Bluetooth-enabled phones, prior to using and pairing your

headset for the first time ,please check if your mobile phone is Bluetooth-enable. The pairing instructions for typical Bluetooth-enable mobile phone are explained on the next page.The headset pairing procedure may vary on the setting of your mobile phone.Please contact the manufacture of your mobile phone or its agent for further information.

Subsequent Pairing Methods

1. Place the headset and the mobile phone where they are easily viewed and no more than 1 meter apart.
 2. Ensure the headset is turned off.
 3. Please press the MFB 5 seconds until “Pairing” voice prompt is heard, the blue&red led quick flash, the headset begins to pair. (Shut down if no operation in 3 seconds)
 4. Activate your mobile phone Bluetooth function, please refer to your mobile phone user guide for details.
 5. Set the mobile phone to search for Bluetooth devices and select “BH-501”from the list of devices shown.
 6. Enter password “0000”and press“ok”to pair your headset with mobile phone ,when the pairing is completed , the headset enters in stand by mode.
- Note: If your Bluetooth mobile phone version is V2.1 or above, don't need match password when using.

7. Now you can use your Bluetooth headset to enjoy the music or make a call. (Note: Some mobile phone ,when they are re-started ,the headset will connect with the mobile phone automatically.)

Automatical Connection

Shut down in standby status or turn off to reboot, the headset will connect with the last paired devices automatically.

Use Your Headset

Answer/Reject a Call

When a call is coming, you will hear the caller ID number voice prompt, press the MFB button once to answer the call or via your mobile phone.

To reject the incoming call, double press the MFB button.

Transfer the Call

During the call, press hold the volume key “+” for 2 seconds to transfer the call from your headset to your mobile phone, repeat the above procedure to transfer the call from mobile phone to your headset. (Please check if your mobile phone has this function)

Call Mute

During the call, press and hold the volume key “-” for 2 seconds with two “Du” tones heard to mute the microphone. Repeat to un-mute. (Note: Under muted status, you will hear “Dong” tone)

End a Call

During the talk, press the MFB button once to end the call or hang up on your mobile phone.

Last Call Redial

In standby mode, double click the MFB to redial the last call you dialed.

Voice Dial

In standby status, press the volume key “+” & “-” simultaneously once, you will hear “Du” tone and speak the name recorded in your contacts or the name that correspond to the number you want to dial.

Notice: prior to voice dialing, please make sure your mobile phone stored the voice tag of your contact. And ensure that your mobile phone’s voice dialing function has been successfully activated. Regarding how to record the voice tag, please refer to your devices user guide.

Bluetooth Music Play/Pause

During the Bluetooth music, press MFB once to pause and press it once again to play again .

(Attention:your mobile phone must support A2DP profile.)

Previous Track

During the music, press the "Previous Track " key to select the last song.

Next Track

During the music, press the "Next Track " key to select the next song.

Turn Up the Volume

(During the call or music) Press the volume "+" once, the volume will be up. Each click per level, until the MAX and you will hear "Di" alarm.

Warm Prompt: Adjust the volume properly to avoid any damages to your hearing.

Turn Down the Volume

(During the call or music) Press the volume "-" once, the volume will be down. Each click per level, until MIN and you will hear "DU" alarm.

Battery level Detected

In standby status, press and hold the volume key "+"&"-"for 1 second to detect the

battery level.

MP3 Player and Operation

Turn MP3 On: In off status, press and hold the “MP3 Play/Pause” key for 3 seconds until the Green indicator lights with “Du” tone.

Turn MP3 Off: In on status, press and hold the “MP3 Play/Pause” key for 4 seconds until the Green indicator lights with “Du” tone.

Play MP3 Music: Turn the MP3 on, plug the micro SD card into the socket and it will play automatically.

Pause MP3 Music: During MP3 music, press the “MP3 Play/Pause” Button to play or pause.

Note: Bluetooth music has priority to play, when Bluetooth music stops, it will play MP3 music.

Troubleshooting

If you are unable to connect your headset with mobile phone, please try the following :

Ensure your headset is turned on and is fully charged.

Ensure the headset is paired with your mobile phone.

Ensure your mobile phone's Bluetooth feature is activated. Please refer to your mobile phone user guide for specific instruction.

Ensure the headset is within a 10 meters range of your mobile headset and there are no with obstructions, such as walls or other electronic devices in between. If the above steps do not solve your problem, please recharge the headset and remove your mobile phone battery for a short time.

Safety Information

Check local laws regarding the use of mobile phones and headsets while driving. If you use the headset while driving, ensure your attention and focus remains on the road and you drive in a responsible and safe manner. Never allow children playing with the headset small parts may be a choking hazard.

Observe all signs that require an electrical device or RF radio product to be switched off in designated areas.

(These could include hospitals, blasting areas, and potentially explosive environments.)

Turn off your headset prior to boarding an aircraft. Do not use your headset in an aircraft.

Never mount or store your headset over any air bag development area as serious injury may result when the air bag deploys.

No not open or mutilate the built-in battery.

Dispose of batteries according to local regulations. Do not dispose as household waste.

Care and Maintenance Headset

Consider turning your headset off before placing it in your pocket or bag. If the MBF is accidentally activated., your mobile phone may place an unintended call.

Do not expose the headset to liquid, moisture or humidity as it is not waterproof.

Do not use abrasive cleaning solvents to clean the headset.

Do not expose the headset to extreme temperature conditions. The best store temperature range is from -10 to +60C, otherwise the life of the headset will be influenced.

Do not dispose of the headset in a fire as it this may result in an explosion.

Do not bring your headset into contact with sharp objects as this will cause scratched and damage.

Do not attempt to disassemble the headset as it dose not contain serviceable components.

Do not attempt to Disassemble the headset.

If you do not use the headset for long periods, be sure to store it in a dry place, free form extreme temperature conditions and dust.
