Getting Started K700

To use your K700 headset please follow the steps below:

1.Ensure your K700 is fully charged.

2.Hold down the MFB button until the light is flashing blue and red, with "Pairing" voice prompt.

3. Pair your K700 with a Bluetooth compatible device.

Charge Your Headset

Connect the charger to a wall outlet and wait for LED red light. The red light will turn off after fully charged.

Turning Your Headset On and Off

Press and hold down the MFB button for 2 seconds until "Power On" voice prompt is heard.

Turning Off the Headset

Press and hold the MFB for approximately 3 seconds until "Power Off" voice prompt and LED flash red and turn off.

Attention: If you will not be using the headset for a while, you should also turn off the Bluetooth function on the device you are pairing it to save battery life.

Pairing Your Headset

K700 works with Bluetooth-enabled devices. Prior to pair, make sure your device is Bluetooth compatible.

Subsequent Pairing

- 1.Hold the MFB for 5 seconds until indicator light flashes red and blue alternately and voice prompt "Pairing" is heard.
- 2.Go into your Bluetooth settings on your mobile phone or other Bluetooth compatible device.
- 3. Select K 700 from the list of devices.
- 4. Press ok to pair your headset.
- 5. When pairing is completed the "Connected" voice prompt will be heard and enter standby. (Note: "0000" is the password when needed.)

Multi-point Connection

Method 1:

Turn off the headset after successfully connected with current mobile phone. Turn on the headset again to pair it with another mobile phone. After successfully connected with another mobile phone, please find the pairing record from the first mobile phoneand active the history pairing by mobile phone.

Method 2:

Turn off the headset after successfully connected with current mobile phone. Turn on the headset again topair it with another mobile phone. Disconnect it after successfully connected with another mobile phone. Turn on the headset again to pair it automatically with 2 devices simultaneously.

Using Your Headset

Shut down in standby status or turn off to reboot, the headset will connect with the last paired devices automatically..

Use Your Headset

Answer/Reject a Call

During an incoming call, the caller ID will be heard via headset. Press the MFB once to answer the call. You will still be able to answer your call from your phone if preferred. If you would like to reject a call, simply press the MFB twice.

Call Mute

During the call, click the "Play/Pause" key to mute the call. (Repeat to return)

Ending a Call

To end a call press the MFB button once or end the call via cell phone.

Voice Dialing from Your Headset

If your mobile phone is equipped with the voice dialing, simply click the MFB once and speak the voice tag according to your mobile device.

Attention: For voice dialing you must record the voice tag into your phone prior to using the voice dialing function on the headset. Please refer to your mobile device's user guide to properly record the voice tag.

Last Number Redialing

In standby status, double press the MFB on your headset.

Adjusting the Volume

Press the volume button repeatedly until you reach desired volume level.

Play/Pause

During Bluetooth mode, click the Play/Pause key to play the music in your phone and repeat to pause.

(Attention:your mobile phone must support A2DP profile.)

Next/Last Track Kev

Use the Next Track key to skip the song or the Last Track key to go back to a song.

Transferring a Call

During the talk, click the Play/Pause key for 3 seconds to transfer the call from your headset to your phone.(Repeat to return)

Connected With the Last Paired Device

The headset will connect with the last paired mobile when turned on. If the pairing is successful voice prompt "Connected" will be heard. When headset is not in working range (usual 10m), the headset will prompt "Out of Range" every 15 seconds and not paired again in 10 minutes it will shut down automatically in 5 minutes. While in standby mode, if pairing cannot be completed in 5 minutes the headset will automatically turn off.

Battery level Detected

In standby status, press and hold the volume key"+"&" "for 1 second to detect the battery level.

Troubleshooting

Try the following steps if connections problems happen:

Ensure your headset is turned on and is fully charged.

Ensure the headset is paired with your mobile phone.

Ensure your mobile phone's Bluetooth feature is activated.

Ensure there are no with obstructions between the mobile phone and headset.

If the steps above do not solve your problem, please recharge the headset and remove your mobile phone battery for a short time.

Safety Information

Do not open or mutilate the built-in battery.

Do not dispose of batteries by fire.

Do not use the headset on the aircraft.

Do not violate the local law while using the headset on driving.

Care and Maintenance Headset

Do not expose the headset to liquid or humid areas.

Do not use abrasive cleaning solvents to clean the headset.

Do not store the battery under extreme high or low temperature.

Do not dispose of the headset in a fire as it this may result in an explosion.

Do not attempt to disassemble the headset by yourself...

Recharge the headset if it is inactive for a long time to keep the best performance.

Charging

Only use the manufacturer supplied charger when charging the headset.

Do not disassemble the charger as it may expose you to dangerous voltages and other risks. Incorrect reassembly can cause electric shock when the headset is subsequently used.

Do not use the charger outdoors or in damp areas. Avoid charging the headset in extreme temperature conditions.
