

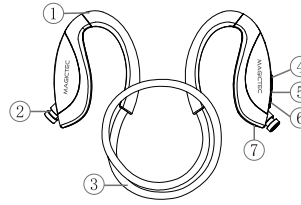

Bluetooth Headset

TAKE A GOOD LOOK

1. Ear-Hook
2. Trumpet Head
3. Memory Line
4. Volume Button
5. LED Indicator
6. Function Key
7. Micro USB Charging Port



Volume Button

- * Volume up/down (1 tap per level change)
- * Move next (Long press 2 second in playing state)

LED Indicator

- * Charging (Solid red. Turn blue when fully charged)
- * Pairing (Blue/red alternately flashes)
- * On/off (On: 3 blue flashes. Off: 3 red flashes)

Function Key

- * Turn on/off (3-second press)
- * Take a call or end it (1 tap)
- * Redial (2 taps)
- * Refuse a call (3-second press during call)
- * Play/pause (1 tap in playing state)

CONNECT TO YOUR PHONE

1. READY

Activate the Bluetooth feature on your phone, then use the phone's settings to add/search/discover new Bluetooth devices.

2. SET

First Time: Please keep your phone and bluetooth in 1-meter range. Activate pairing mode by 3-second press function key. The LED flashes blue/red to indicate pairing mode.

3. CONNECT

Select "MAGICTEC" from the list of Bluetooth devices shown on your phone.

If phone asks for a passcode, enter four zeros (0000). You may see **** on screen.

Headset LED will start flashing blue once your phone and headset are successfully paired/connected.

4. PAIRING TO YOUR SECOND PHONE

After A phone connected, turn off the headset. Then activate the headset again into pairing mode, connect to B phone.

After a successful connection, turn off the headset. Then turn it on again, 1 blue flashing, both A and B phones connected.

Notes: When multipoint is used, some functions are limited.

LISTEN TO THE VOICE

POWER ON	After 3-second pressing function key
POWER OFF	After 3-second pressing function key when the headset is on
CONNECTED	After the headset and phone are successfully connected
LOW BATTERY	Before the battery should be recharged
PHONE NUMBER	When there is an incoming call

TIPS

* Ensure the headset is within 33 feet (10 meters) range of your mobile phone and there are no obstructions, such as walls or other electronic devices.

If the above steps do not solve your problem, please recharge the headset and remove your mobile phone battery for a short time.
