Safety Note: The enclosed batteries must not be charged!
(1) Remove the batteries from the mouse and plug out the dongle from the computer
(2) Plug in the dongle to the computer
(3) In the first 15 seconds after the dongle is plugged, place the mouse as close as possible to the dongle (less than 1 cm ). Press and hold right button and middle button (inside the battery compartment) and install the batteries to the mouse
(4) Keep holding the right button and middle button for 2 seconds and then release them
(5) Test the mouse for function. If the pairing process was not
successful, repeat the instructions from step (1)
