The Elite 800X Headset and Transmitter come paired out of the box. When paired, with both the Headset and Transmitter powered on, the Transmitter's LED will be on solid BL, but not blinking. However, if your Transmitter's LED is double-blinking, follow the steps below to pair your Headset and Transmitter. Start this process with the headset powered OFF.

Make sure the Xbox One is fully powered on and stand in a Xbox Live profile before connecting the Transmitter for the first time.

- Go to the Xbox One Home Screen and Press **X** on the Xbox One Controller.
- Go to Settings > Display & Sound > Optical Audio, Select Bitstream Out.
