2. MAXIMUM PERMISSIBLE EXPOSURE Prediction

Prediction of MPE limit at a given distance

Equation from page 18 of OET Bulletin 65, Edition 97-01

$$S = PG/4\pi R^2$$

S = Power density

P = power input to antenna

G = power gain of the antenna in the direction of interest relative to an isotropic radiator

R = distance to the center of radiation of the antenna

3. RESULTS

The power density level at 20 cm is 0.07920 mW/cm², which is below the uncontrolled exposure limit of 0.557 mW/cm² at 836.00 MHz for CDMA band. The power density level at 20 cm is 0.11343 mW/cm², which is below the uncontrolled exposure limit of 1.0 mW/cm² at 1880.00 MHz for PCS band.
