1. Appearance and Buttons:



1.2 POWER

Startup: Press and hold the power button for about 3 seconds.

Shutdown: Press and hold the power button for about 5 seconds. If the shutdown dialogue box pops up, select "Shut Down" and "OK."

Lock screen: Press the power button to lock or unlock the screen. When the battery is drained, the system will shut down automatically.

1.3 Return

Short press Return to return to the last screen.

Long pressing return will bring you to the home screen

1.4 Volume +, Volume-

Use the volume buttons to adjust the sound intensity

1.5 Headphone Jack

3.5 mm standard headphone jack

1.6 HDMI

Use an HDMI cable to connect your device to an HDTV

1.7 Micro SD

Insert a Micro SD card to expand your storage space by up to 32GB

1.8 Mini USB

Use a USB cable to connect your device to a computer and transfer files

1.9 Reset

If the tablet should freeze, long press the power button to force a restart

【Remark】: Only use the reset button when normal shutdown is impossible

2. First use

2.1 Battery Management and Charging

Charge the battery for 6 hours before first use.

After that, the device can be charged in 4 hours.

Charge using only the provided adapter, or USB cable.


When charging, the battery icon will fill, and contain a lightning bolt.

When fully charged, the icon will be full, and green.

Charge, and use your tablet at least once a month to keep your battery strong

2.2 Connection with PC

When you connect your device to a computer, your device will show this screen:



Tap "Turn on USB storage" to transfer files to your device.

3. Device Operation

3.1 Home screen

This is the screen you will see after powering on your device



You can customize this screen with icons and widgets

Tap and hold anywhere on the desktop to customize background:



Tap the icon on the top right to show everything installed on your device:



Tap and hold on an item to move it to your home screen

3.2 Status Bar

The status bar can be found at the bottom of the screen
 The right side shows USB, MicroSD, Battery, and other notifications.
 Swipe up from the bottom on the right for even more options
 The left side shows the Back, Home, Tasks, and Menu buttons.

3.3 Touchscreen



No matter what screen you are on, you can always get back to the home screen by pressing this icon located on the bottom left..

Press the Back button to go to the previus screen


Press the menu button for more options


To enter Settings, click the Settings icon:

Enter settings and tap "Apps"


To uninstall an app, tap the name of the app, and tap uninstall



4.3 Privacy


Factory Date Reset

This will delete everything from your tablet, and restore everything to defaults




4.4 Date & Time

6. Troubleshooting

- 1. Device won't power on
 - 1) Check the battery power
 - 2) Connect the power adapter, then check again
 - 3) If it doesn't turn on after this, contact the supplier
- 2. The device appears to be starting, then turns off
 - 1) Charge the battery
- 3. No sound can be heard
 - 1) Make sure the volume is turned up
 - 2) Try another sound file. It may be damaged.
- 4. Can't copy files to the device
 - 1) Check connection between PC and device
 - 2) Make sure the device has available space
 - 3) Make sure the USB cable isn't damaged
