





Assembly


1. INSTALLING CARD

Install the memory card as shown in the figure.



2. CHARGING YOUR TABLET

Connect your device to a power outlet using the inbox charger and USB-C cable to charge your tablet.




3. TURNING ON YOUR TABLET

- 1. Press and hold the Power button for 4~5 seconds until the onn. Logo appears.
- 2. At the Start-up screen, swipe up from the bottom of the screen to unlock.
- 3. Once you' ve arrived at the home screen, you can begin using your tablet.



4. TURNING OFF YOUR TABLET




Operation

1. TABLET UPDATES

Connect the device to the internet.

Tab on "Settings" > "System" > "System Update".





2. CONNECTING TO THE INTERNET

Go to Settings > Network & internet > Internet Tap on Wi-Fi to activate wireless connectivity.



3. CONNECTING BLUETOOTH

Turn on the compatible Bluetooth device and make it discoverable.

Open the "Settings" > "Connected devices".

Tap on Pair new device view available devices.







Cleaning & Care

1. CLEANING

Do not use alcohol, thinner or benzene to clean the surface of the tablet. Use only cleaning products designed for computer tablet devices.

2. PREVENTION

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution/Prevention		
Cannot turn my device on.	 Press and hold the power button for more than 3 seconds. Charge the tablet for 10-15 minutes. 		
My tablet does not charge.	 Use the in-box charger and USB cable to charge your tablet. Check whether the power outlet is working, and the charger is correctly plugged into the outlet. Reconnect the charger to the device and let it charge for 10-15 minutes. Then press the power button to check if there is a charging prompt. 		
My tablet runs slow.	Close or uninstall unwanted applications.
