### Get started

#### CHARGE THE BATTERY

Charge your tablet fully (4.5 hours) before using it the first time. After the first time, charge your battery when it is less than 15% full.



- 1. Insert the micro USB cable into your tablet's micro USB port.
- Insert the other end into the wall charger, then connect it to a power outlet.
   Note: It takes about 4.5 hours to fully charge your tablet.



### Conserve battery power

- Turn on battery saver mode. See <u>Adjust the power saving settings (on</u> page 26).
- Turn off Wi-Fi when you aren't using it.
- Lower the screen brightness. See <u>Adjust the screen brightness (on page 25)</u>.
- Close apps that you aren't using. See <u>Use the Recents screen (on</u> page 15).
- If your tablet is inactive, your tablet sleeps with the screen off (depending on the screen timeout setting. See <u>Customize the lock screen (on page 24)</u>). Press 0 to wake it up.
- If you are using an animated wallpaper, change it to a static wallpaper.

### Helpful tips

- For the best battery performance, use your tablet often.
- Make sure that you charge it at least once a month.
- Use the wall charger that came with your tablet for charging.
- You can use your tablet while it is being charged. However, to conserve your tablet's battery life, it isn't recommended.

### TURN ON YOUR TABLET FOR THE FIRST TIME

1. Press and hold the  $\circ$  button on the side of your tablet until you see the *Welcome* screen.



2. Select your language, then follow the instructions on the screen to complete setup.

**Note:** You can use your tablet without connecting to the Internet and signing into a Google<sup>™</sup> account, but you won't be able to use the Play Store or receive software updates.

#### TURN YOUR TABLET ON OR OFF

### Turn on your tablet

Press and hold the Obutton. Your tablet turns on.



#### Note

If you don't touch your tablet for a while (depending on the screen timeout setting), it may sleep with the screen off. Press  $\bigcirc$  briefly to wake it up.

### Turn off your tablet

1. Press and hold the 0 button until the *Power off* screen opens.



2. Tap Power off. Your tablet turns off.





### RESTART YOUR TABLET

 Press and hold the power button for 10 seconds. Your stored data and customized settings aren't affected.

### Note

To reset your tablet back to factory settings, see <u>Reset to default settings (on page 51)</u>.

### ADJUST THE VOLUME

### Note

Press the volume + or - button to raise or lower the volume.

### NAVIGATE WITH GESTURES

Gesture	Action
Тар	Tap an app or another item with your finger to open or select it.
Touch & hold	Touch an item with your finger and do not release it until your tablet responds.
Drag	Touch and hold an item with your finger, then move your finger to the position where you want the item.

Gesture	Action
Swipe	Quickly slide your finger either vertically or horizontally across the screen to scroll up and down or right and left.
Pinch	Pinch your fingers together or move them apart to zoom in and out.

#### USE THE RECENTS SCREEN

The *Recents* screen lets you quickly switch to recently used and open apps. If you have too many apps running, your tablet may run slower or shorten your battery life. Close apps you are not using to improve your tablet's performance.

On the home screen, tap ☐ Recents. A list of the most recently used or running apps appears.







### Update your tablet

### Warning

Back up your personal data before updating your tablet. Updates may delete your data.

1. Tap Apps > Settings > About tablet.



- 2. Tap **System Update > Check update**. If an update is available, your tablet displays the update version information.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to install.

### Update your apps

- 1. Tap Apps > Play Store.
- 2. Tap = (menu) in the upper-left corner of the search bar, then tap My apps.
- 3. Locate the app you want to update from the ALL tab.
- 4. Tap the app to open the app page, then tap **UPDATE**.
- 5. Tap **CONTINUE** or **ACCEPT** if you agree to the app permissions. Your app is updated.

#### CUSTOMIZE THE HOME SCREEN

### Change the wallpaper

1. Touch and hold on the home screen until a menu appears.



- 2. Tap WALLPAPERS.
- 3. Tap the wallpaper you want to use. To select a photo you took, tap **Pick** image.
- 4. Tap **Set wallpaper**.

### Tip

Animated wallpapers use more battery. To conserve battery, use a static wallpaper.

### Add an item to the home screen

- 1. Tap Apps to show all apps.
- 2. Touch and hold the app you want to add until it moves to the home screen.

Tip

You can also add or remove items from the favorites tray.

#### Move a home screen item

- 1. Touch and hold the item you want to move until it's highlighted.
- 2. Drag the item to where you want it, then release your finger.



#### Remove a home screen item

#### Note

Removing an item from the home screen doesn't delete the app. See Uninstall apps (on page 51).

- 1. Touch and hold the item you want to remove until it is highlighted.
- 2. Drag the item over the X, then release your finger.



#### Create a folder

- 1. Touch and hold the app you want to move into a folder until it is highlighted.
- 2. Drag the app on top of another app until a white circle appears, then release your finger. A folder is created.





3. Tap the folder to open it, then tap **Unnamed Folder** to open the keyboard and name the folder. Tap when finished.



4. To add more items, drag them into the folder.


### Note

To remove apps from a folder, open the folder, touch and hold the app, then drag it back to the home screen. The folder is deleted when only one app is left inside.

#### SET AND USE THE SCREEN LOCK

### Change your lock type

1. Tap Apps > Settings > Security > Screen lock.



2. Tap the screen lock type you want to use, then follow the on-screen instructions.




#### Unlock the screen

There are several ways to unlock your tablet, depending on which screen lock is enabled. You may need to:

- · Swipe up on the screen.
- Drag your finger to enter a pattern.
- Enter a PIN or password.

### Set the lock screen timeout

- Tap ⊕ Apps > 
   Settings > 
   Display.
- 2. Tap **Sleep**, then select how long before your inactive tablet sleeps.

### Add lock screen message

### Tip

- 1. Tap Apps > Settings > Security > Lock screen message.
- 2. Type the text you want to display on the lock screen, then tap **SAVE**.
- 3. Press  $\circ$  to put your tablet to sleep, then press  $\circ$  again to wake it up. The lock screen opens and your text is displayed.



#### Remove owner info

- 1. Tap Apps > Settings > Security > Lock screen message.



#### SET THE DATE AND TIME

- Tap ⊕ Apps > **Settings > Oate & time.** 
  - Automatically or manually set your date and time.
  - Select your time zone.
  - Choose your hour format (12-hour or 24-hour).
  - Choose your date format.

#### ADJUST THE SCREEN BRIGHTNESS

 Drag your two fingers down from the top of the screen to view status items, then drag the slider left or right.



#### ADJUST THE POWER SAVING SETTINGS

To help improve battery life, battery saver reduces your device's performance and limits vibration, location services, and most background data. Email, messaging, and other apps that rely on syncing may not update unless you open them. To turn on battery saver mode:

- Tap ⊕ Apps > \$\square\$ Settings > \$\bigsimes\$ Battery > Battery saver
- 2. Tap the slider to turn on Battery saver mode. The edges of your screen may turn orange while battery saver mode is turned on.



### Tip

Battery saver mode automatically turns off when your tablet is charging.

3. Use the available options to change additional power settings, as needed.

### Conserve battery power

- Turn on battery saver mode. See <u>Adjust the power saving settings</u> (above).
- Turn off Wi-Fi when you aren't using it.
- Lower the screen brightness. See <u>Adjust the screen brightness (on the previous page</u>).
- Close apps that you aren't using. See <u>Use the Recents screen (on page 15)</u>.
- If your tablet is inactive, your tablet sleeps with the screen off (depending on the screen timeout setting. See <u>Customize the lock screen (on page 24)</u>). Press Oto wake it up.
- If you are using an animated wallpaper, change it to a static wallpaper.

### SETTING THE SCREEN FONT SIZE

- 1. Tap ⊕ Apps > ♥ Settings > ♥ Display > Font size.
- 2. Select the font size you want.

### ADJUST SYSTEM SOUNDS

Change your notification tones, system volume, and other sound settings.

### Adjust media, alarm, and notification volume level

- 1. Tap Apps > Settings > Sound & notification.
- 2. Under *Sound*, use the sliders to adjust your media, alarm, and notification volume.

### Turn on or off keyboard or screen lock volume

- 1. Tap Apps > Settings > Sound & notification.
- 2. Under Sound, tap Other sounds.
- Tap the sliders to turn on or off the screen lock, charging, and touch feedback.


### SELECT YOUR LANGUAGE

Change your system language or add an additional language to your keyboard.

### Change the system language

- 1. Tap ⊕ Apps > 

  Settings > ⊕ Language & input > Language.
- 2. Select the language you want from the list. Your system (including the keyboard) language changes.





### Add a keyboard language

By default, your tablet uses the system language as its keyboard language. If you want to add an additional language to your keyboard:

1. While the keyboard is open, touch and hold *I* (slash) or , (comma) until a settings icon appears.



- 2. Tap Languages.
- 3. Tap the languages you want to use on your keyboard.

### Note

If the languages are grayed out, tap **Use system language** to enable them.

### Switch keyboard language

Make sure that you have enabled additional languages on your keyboard (see steps above).

Tap ⊕ to toggle between keyboard languages. The keyboard language appears in the space bar.



### Connect to a computer

For more information on viewing and transferring files, see your computer's documentation.

#### **WINDOWS**

- 1. Connect the Micro USB cable from your tablet to your computer.
- Open Computer or My Computer, then click your model number (NS-P10A8100) icon to view or transfer files.
- 3. Open Notifications, then tap the USB connection entry. The *Use USB for* window opens.
- 4. Tap File transfers.
- 5. Unplug the cable when you are finished.



- 2. Tap the slider on turn on Wi-Fi. Your tablet automatically scans for available networks.

  - If the network is open, your tablet connects automatically.




If the Wi-Fi icon has a (lock), the network is secured. Enter the password, then tap CONNECT.

A connection icon appears in the status bar when your tablet is connected.

#### ADD A WI-FINFTWORK

- 1. Tap <sup>⊕</sup> Apps > <sup>‡</sup> Settings > ▼ Wi-Fi.
- 2. Tap the slider <a> to turn on Wi-Fi</a> .



3. Tap i (options), then tap Add network.



- 4. Enter the Network SSID (name), then select the type of security you want from the drop-down menu. You can select:
  - None—No security.
  - **WEP**—Wired Equivalent Privacy. **Note:** A password is required.
  - WPA/WPA2 PSK—Wi-Fi Protected Access. Note: A password is required.
  - **802.1x EAP**—802.1x Extensible Authentication Protocol.

5. Tap **CONNECT**. Your new network appears in the list of available networks.



# What should I do if I cannot turn on my tablet?

# Can I open Microsoft Office and PDF files on my tablet?

You can purchase and download third party applications to read these files.

# What should I do if my tablet won't recognize the microSD™ card?

- Make sure that you have inserted a microSD card correctly and securely.
- With the microSD card inserted, turn off your tablet, then turn it back on.
- Make sure that you are attempting to view your files in the correct location on your tablet.

#### What should I do if I can't access the Internet?

- Look for a wireless signal indicator (♥) in the status bar at the top of the screen. If there is no icon, you are not connected.
- Make sure that Wi-Fi is turned on. See <u>Connect to a Wi-Fi network (on page 30)</u>.
