






<Dipole Verification Data> - D2450V2, serial no. 736 (Data of Measurement : 08.15.2023) D2450V2 MHz - Head

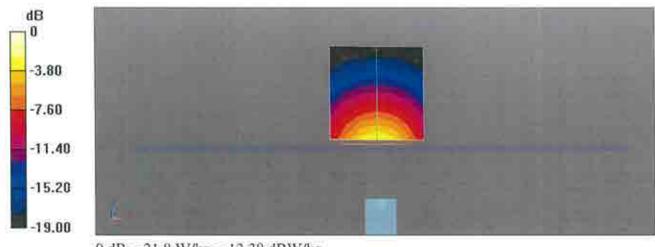







- Field polarization: Above the open horn, linear polarization of the field is expected. This is verified graphically in the field representation.

 Local peak E-field (V/m) and average of peak spatial components of the poynting vector (W/m²) averaged over the surface area of 1 cm² and 4cm² at the nominal operational frequency of the verification source. Both square and circular averaging results are listed.




