

1. GETTING STARTED

ITEMS INCLUDED:

(music player shipped separately)




- 1. Wireless Receiver Box
- 2. Receiver Power Supply (with assorted power prongs)
- 3. 10ft Power Cord Extension (2)
- 4. Transmitter Power Supply (with assorted power prongs) (2)
- 5. Audio Cable
- 6. Wireless Transmitter Box

2. SET UP MEDIA PLAYER

If installing a new Mood Media I Muzak music player (shipped separately), follow the User Guide Setup Instructions included with the player.

3. SET UP SPEAKERS & TRANSMITTER

- 1. Attach audio cable to transmitter.
- 2. Attach other end of audio cable to Audio Out A (or Audio Zone 1) on player.
- 3. Attach power supply to transmitter.
- 4. Attach transmitter power plug to power outlet.
- 5. Attach receiver power plug to power outlet
- 6. Attach power supply to receiver.
- 7. Attach audio cable to receiver
- 8. Attach other end of audio cable to Audio In on voice box



Wireless Receiver Tips

Place receiver in horizontal position with antenna in vertical position. When all power supplies are turned on and audio cable is connected to a voice box, you will begin receiving a signal Do not place within 5 feet of a microwave oven.

Wireless Transmitter Tips

Place transmitter in horizontal position with antenna in vertical position. Speakers are pre-paired to transmitter provided.

When all power supplies are turned on and audio cable is connected to transmitter, you will begin receiving a signal.

Do not place within 5 feet of a microwave oven.

To set a new wireless signal:

- 1. Turn off all speakers.
- 2. Initiate transmitter pairing mode by pressing the pairing button to the left of the power light for greater than 3 seconds (a paper clip or pin will work).
- 3. Immediately turn on all speakers and transmitter should now show a solid green light and speakers will remain paired.
