Chapter 1 Preface

1-1 Introduction

GT-95 Care communicator enable you to know where your cared ones are all the times. User friendly, easy to management.

- Easy to use. Suitable for kids and elders
- Compact size. Fashion look.
- Regular report function. You always know
- Voice guide, tracking and setting can be done through both calling and SMS
- POI reference report (SMS); Position indicated by Map(MMS)
- SOS function, calls and SMS will all be triggered when emergency to protect your cared ones

1-2 Notice

1-2-1 GPS position error

All GPS has some position error, the reference positions indicated by GT-95 are for your reference only, may also have errors.

The reference positions types :

1. Real time position : When GPS under good signal.
2. Last recorded position : When GPS in bad signal, the last recorded position information will be send under request.

1-2-2 Emergency contacts

Please set the emergency contacts according to priority when first use.

After setting, GT-95 will send an SMS to emergency contacts to double confirm.

1-2-3 SMS/MMS report delay

SMS/MMS report may delay during grand holidays (Christmas, New year etc.) caused by data overflow in carrier sides.

1-2-4 Password management

GT-95 is designed to be use to connect you with your cared ones. In order to protect user privacy, a password is required in setting related movement.

◎Default Password◎

The default password of GT-95 is 『0000』, Please change the password once you get the device.

◎Changing your password regularly◎

1-2-5 Maintenance

Your GT-95 contains sensitive electronic components that should be handled carefully. Obey the following directions to meet guarantee requirements.

- Keep the device dry. Rain drops, humidity and all sorts of liquids may be a cause of corrosion of electricity chains. If the device got wet, take out the battery and let the device get fully dry, then handle to your local dealer.





Chapter 3 Start-up

3-1、Inserting SIM card and battery

All SIM cards must be kept in a safe place. You may request your SIM card supplier to provide SIM card and information about the use of SIM card-related services. The supplier may be a service supplier, a network operator or another seller. The SIM card must be inserted in the way as set below.

NOTE: The SIM card should be password free, otherwise it will fail to function in GT-95.



Note: Before removing the cover, switch off the device and disconnect it from the charger or PC. The device must be always kept and used with a cover and screwed tightly.

3-2、Charging the battery

Before you can use the GT-95, you must fully charge the battery. By connecting the device to one of the USB connectors of a PC or by using the charger available in the set, it is possible to charge the internal battery of your GT-95. For the first time, it is advised to charge the battery using the charger (not via PC) for about 8 hours.

Chapter 4 Setting your GT-95

4-1、Start the PC software

Power off your GT-95 before connects with your computer. The removal disk will show up in your computer. Find the file named TrackTool.

Double click the icon  to run the tracktool.

Important Notice: *The files in the T-card are very important for your usage of GT-95, please back up the files in T-card once you start use in case it deleted or damaged when use improperly.*



4-2、Install USB driver

Click the Install PC software button to install PC software according instruction if needed.


4-3、Personal Setting

Click the Setup Device button to enter setup mode. Access Password will be required.

The default password of GT-95 is 『0000』



The personal setting interface is as blow.



User name: User of GT-95

SOS message: Message for emergency use can be set here. When SOS button be triggered, a SMS with pre-set content here+location information will be sent to emergency contacts.

Language: The language of voice guiding system can be set here.

Time Zone: Setting Time Zone here.

Password: In order to protect privacy, password is required when changing settings though both PC and authorized mobile.

The default password 『0000』 can be changed here.

Shutdown: The machine can be shut down directly or to be shut down with permission of authorized Mobile.

Distance Unit: Distance Unit can be set here.

MMS setting: Please contact your local carrier for MMS setting related information.

For your operation convenience, you can add related MMS setting in this telecom company list by adding setting information to file X:/TrackTool/MMS.

The format should be is as below:



Please special attention to MMS Setting, MMS can't work normally without correct setting.

The Mobile should also support MMS function; otherwise it can not get the MMS sent by GT-95.

4-4、 Phone Setting

The phone setting interface is as below:



In order to protect privacy, you can choose **20 phone number** to be authorized number which can accessible to GT-95. (You can also choose to **Allow All Phone Number**. Those not listed can only call in, and GT-95 can pick up as normal phone.)

The **No. 1, 2, 3** are **speed dial No.s** which indicated as emergency contacts. Please set these **3 No.** according to the priority.

4-5、 Geo fence Setting

GT-95 supports 4 sets of Geo fence.

- Geo fences 1&2 are “regular” Geo fences (eg. “home”, “school”), fill in related longitude, latitude in Geo Fence setting interface to set or open Map to set.

NOTE:

In Some countries, the longitude, latitude information of a place indicated in Google map is not accurate, may have big error from actual location. The information in Google Earth is more accurate. Therefore, when setting the Geo fence please also consult Google Earth. (Google Map is the product of Google.)

Different bound can be set by choosing between different **Radius**.

Both in and out of the fence will be report to emergency contacts.



(Geo fences 1& 2 can only be set through PC. Enable and Disable both by PC and authorized mobile.)

- Gen fence 3 are causal one, which suitable to use in park/outside/playground. Out of Geo fence 3 will be reported.


(Geo fence 3 can only be set and canceled through authorized mobile by SMS or call.)

- Gen fence 4 is for parking, double click Power button to Start/Cancel. Out of Geo fence 4 will be reported every 1 minute through SMS.

(Geo fence 4 can be set and canceled through authorized mobile by SMS or call.)



4-6、Report Setting




Periodical report can be set here. (disable, 1-120minutes)

Report on Time function supports 4 sets reports on pre-set time of a day. Report on Time 4 is for causal use, only effect for 24 hours. GT-95 will report position to emergency contacts No.1 on pre-set time.

- **Report on Time 1, 2 & 3 can only be set through PC. Enable and Disable both by PC and authorized mobile.**
- **Report on Time 4 can be set and canceled through authorized mobile.**

4-7、Service Center

The service center interface is as below, please contact your service provider for related information.



Chapter 5 Operating the device

5-1、 Turn on

When the device is off, press the power button for 2 seconds to turn on the device.

5-2、 Turn off

Under Shut Down Directly mode: Press the power button of a power on machine for 3 seconds to turn off.

Under SMS for Shut Down mode: Press the power button of a power on machine for 3 seconds, a SMS require for turn off will be send to emergency contacts, GT-95 will be turn off with the permission of Contact No.1.

5-3、 Call pick up

Press any key (except SOS and power button) to pick up an incoming call.

5-4、 Call hang up

Press power button to hang up.

5-5、 Making a phone call

To dial emergency contacts No.1, 2, 3, press speed dial button 3 times in 1 second.

5-6、 Adjusting the volume

Press volume button “+” to volume up and “-”down when on the phone (7 levels adjustable)

5-7、 Ringtone or Vibrating alert

Press volume buttons “+” and “-” to adjust the volume of ringtone when GT-95 has an incoming call. 7 level volume adjustable, the lowest one is silent.

Vibrating is on all the time.

The adjustment of ringtone will be automatically saved.

5-8、 SOS function

Press SOS button for 3 seconds, the SOS mode will be triggered. GT-95 will call 3 emergency contacts in turn.

SOS messages with pre-set content + position information will be sent to all 3 emergency contacts.

In occasion when GPS in bad signal, a message with **【the previous position】** will be sent to emergency contacts

5-9、 Low battery alerts

When battery is less than 10%, the Power indicator will turn red and blink; A message of low battery warning will be sent to emergency contact No. 1.

GT-95 will turn off without warning emergency contacts when the battery ran out.

Chapter 6 Tracking/Monitoring/Setting your GT-95 through authorized mobile

GT-95 has a powerful system to enable tracking/ monitoring/ setting through authorized mobile. GT-95 saving you from commands memorization with a user friendly voice guide system.

So, sending the commands through SMS, or follow the voice instruction, the tracking/monitoring/setting of your GT-95 can be done.

Below is the instruction of how to connect you with your cared one through mobile all the time.

Chapter 7 Q&A

1 · Why I can't turn on GT-95? Why the LED indicator of GSM is always in red, and can't turn in green?

A: Please check your SIM card, if it is properly installed. Some SIM cards from operators need to unlock before using them. Use a cell-phone to manage un-lock the pin-code, save the configuration. And then put it back to GT-95 and the SIM card should work this time.

2 · Why I didn't get my MMS report after inquiring?

A : 1. Please make sure that the SIM card used in GT-95 registered the MMS service.

2. Please make sure that the MMS setting in your GT-95 is compatible with the setting of your operator.

3. Please make sure that your mobile support the MMS function.

4. The data transmission may fail When GT-95 or your mobile are in poor signal areas.

3 · Why the GPS can't be fixed, as the GPS Led indicator is always shining in red, not in blue?

A : 1. Please make sure GT-95 is in open area .

2. It takes around 70s for GT-95 to fix position when cold start in an open environment.

3. when start 8-10 hours later after last use, move to out door the position GT-95 can fix in about 30-40s.

4. GT-95 can't fix the position when inside house.

4 · Why 4 LED lights blinking all the time?

A : 1. Please check the T-card under the battery, if it is properly installed (The T-card is special designed for GT-95, please keep it safe).

2. Please re-install the T-card or handle the machine to local distributor.

5 · When GT-95 indoor, how can I know the position of GT-95?

A: When GT-95 can't fix position when indoor. But GT-95 will save the last fixed position outdoor which is outside of the building and report when request.

6 · Why I kept getting the in/out Geo Fence alerts?

A : When start Geo fence is set indoor or besides window, as the GPS signal is not stable, the position drifting sometimes. Enlarge the radius of the Geo Fence and avoid use in poor signal area.

7 · How to prolong the using hours of GT-95?

A : GT-95 has built in G-sensor, GPS will be turned off when GT-95 is still to enter power saving mode. Avoiding use in poor signal areas(GSM/GPS), as searching for signals consume lots energy.

8 · Why all LED lights turned red when power on GT-95?

A: For the first use of GT-95, it takes longer time for system configuration. This is normal, and soon the machine will work normally.

9 · Why there is some position error with GT-95

A : All GPS has some position error, especial under and bad weather condition or environment.(indoor, in car, downtown with high buildings).
