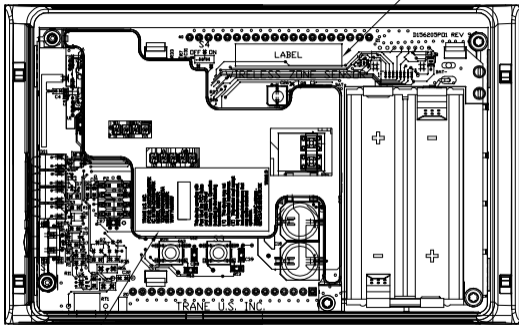

The EUT has a "wall mounted" back cover that the end consumer attaches to their wall. The rest of the product (with the PCB and label exposed) is later snapped onto this back cover to hold the product on the wall. The label is visible to the user at the time of installation and when batteries are placed in the product, consistent with labeling requirements for both countries.
