Dear Sir/Madam,

The transmitter was designed to operate in the frequency bands 400-470MHz.

To aid equipment authorization in other countries which accept the United States FCC Grant for certification, RCA Communications Systems is requesting that the FCC lists the frequencies 400-470MHz, under FCC Rules Parts 90 on the FCC Grant.

For the FCC's Rule Part 90 applications, this radio is used in systems by Federal and Public Safety agencies including Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services, etc. as indicated in the table below. Equipment programming is the responsibility of Authorized Service Personnel. Also, the radio complies with 47 CFR Part 90.203(e), in that the operator can not directly program the transmit frequencies using the normally accessible external controls.

RCA Communications Systems attests that the repeater will not be marketed to USA users with the frequency band which is not allowed by the rule part 90.

Per the FCC's KDB634817 guidance, as an alternative to listing the exact frequencies, we acknowledge that it's a violation of the FCC Rules if this device operates on unauthorized frequencies.
